Do you own this product?

BlendJet2 portable blender

Portable blender with a rechargeable lithium-ion battery, sold in various colours.

Products with serial numbers in the following range may be affected: 5201000000 to 5542999999.

The serial number is printed on the bottom of the base.

Model: BlendJet2

Dates sold: 1 October 2020 - 1 November 2023

Recall updated 14 August 2025: BlendJet Inc has gone out of business in the United States and is no longer operating in all international markets, including Australia.

Why the product is recalled: The metal blades may break while the blender is in use. Separately, the blender may overheat and catch fire when charging or while in use.



Hazard: There is a risk of serious injury from choking or lacerations if broken blade pieces become mixed with food or drinks and consumed. Injuries have occurred.

There is a risk of serious burn injuries or property damage if the blender overheats or short circuits and catches fire. Fires with associated burn injuries and property damage have occurred.

- 1. Stop using the blender immediately. If you purchased the blender from Blendjet directly, you should dispose of it. Do not donate or resell the blender.
- 2. Blendjet is no longer operating and is unable to provide consumers with a remedy.



Important message from the ACCC to consumers: If you purchased the blender from another retailer, you may have rights to a remedy from that retailer in accordance with the <u>consumer guarantees</u>, which may, in certain circumstances, entitle you to a refund or replacement product that is free of defects.
