VOLUME UP AND DOWN

PRESS THE VOLUME BUTTON +/-.

NOTE: BT VOLUME IS CONTROLLED FROM THE PHONE, NOT FROM THE MUFF.

BT/PAIRING MODE

PRESS DOWN AND HOLD THE BT BUTTON FOR 2 SECONDS UNTIL THE BLUE/RED LED IS FLASHING.

LOOK FOR "CHAMPION" TO PAIR WITH YOUR DEVICE.

A QUICK PRESS OF THE BT BUTTON WILL LET THE USER ANSWER A CALL OR START/STOP MUSIC.

PRESSING THE BT BUTTON LONGER THAN 2 SECONDS WILL TURN THE BT OFF.



POWER ON/OFF

PRESS THE POWER BUTTON FOR 2 SECONDS, TO TURN THE UNIT ON. PRESS FOR ANOTHER 2 SECONDS TO TURN THE UNIT OFF.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

CAREFULLY PULL OUT THE FOAM FROM THE INSIDE OF BOTH EAR CUPS AND INSTALL THE BATTERIES IN THE CORRECT DIRECTION AS SHOWN ON THE FOAM INSERTS. AFTER THE BATTERIES ARE CAREFULLY INSTALLED, REINSERT THE FOAM INTO THE MUFF.
