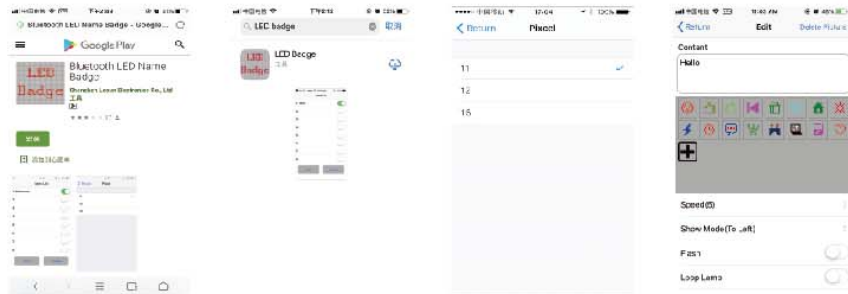


Bluetooth LED Badge Instruction

- 1 Turn on Cellphone Bluetooth Function
- 2 Scan the QR Code and Install App
Or Search "LED Badge" in App Store;
Or Search "Bluetooth LED Name Badge" in Google Play
- 3 Run App



- 4 Settings: Tick "11" for NB1144, NB1155, LB1144;
Tick "12" for NB1248
- 5 Click the Message and Edit
- 6 Turn on the bluetooth on badge: Turn on the badge, then press the On/Off button again, then bluetooth icon comes out, As picture1 shows
(Automatic pairing, no need to choose)
- 7 Send the Message
- 8 LED Badge show the message
