

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SAFETY & WARNINGS

- Don't drag. This protects you, your equipment.
- Check the assembly guide for required components.
- Assembly requires 2 people. It's always easier with a friend.
- Assembling the product on a soft surface protects its finish.
- Avoid loose screws. Tighten fixtures every few months.



ASSEMBLY

- Assemble furniture using the provided instructions.
- Do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is completed to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

Placement

- Keep furniture on flat, level surfaces. Uneven placement may cause deformation.
- Do not place heavy objects on furniture.
- When repositioning furniture always lift, don't drag.
- Keep sharp objects away. They cause scratches and splinters to the surface.
- Do not stack furniture.

Step 1:

Align a leg frame (2) with the holes on the bottom of the body (1). Insert a bolt (A) and lock (C) with Washer (B) into hole. Tighten the bolt with your hand until it's fingertight. Repeat this for the remaining holes and then repeat the process for the remaining leg frames (2, 3 & 4).








Step 2:

Tighten all bolts with the Allen key (D).



Step 3:

Fit the piece of furniture to the ground and place it upright on a level surface.




Disassembling the Door

Follow the steps below to disassemble your doors when needed.


Step 1:

Loosen the screw at the end of the hinge arm.



Step 2:

Centrally the door so that it is separated from the body.



Reverse the steps above to get the doors attached again.

Anti-Tip Kit Installation

We strongly recommend to install anti tip kit for safety.

Wall Fixings

Identify your wall composition and contact your local hardware store to get the appropriate fixings.


Wood

Fixing to wood, make sure that it is not 'decades screws' as easily pull away from the core structure.




Brick or Masonry

Use an appropriate wall plug provided you're sure your wall is sound.




Cavity Wall

Special toggle wall plugs are needed. Seek expert advice.

Step 1:


Attach the brackets **a** securely to the ends of the product using the screws **c** provided.


The instructions below demonstrate how to attach the sofa to the wall using wall anchors or brackets. However, you must identify the type of your wall and choose the appropriate wall fixings.

Step 2:

Determine where the piece is to be placed and mark locations on the wall for the mounting brackets using a pencil. Move the furniture out of the way so that the brackets can then be mounted to the wall.


Step 3:

Dr. holes for the wall plugs using a drill. Knock the plugs into the holes using a hammer. Place the brackets against the plugs again and fix the brackets with the long screws.




Step 4:

Locate the nylon strap (b) down through the brackets. Slide the thin end of the strap through the receiving end on the nylon strap. Pull to tighten the piece of furniture snug against wall.

CLEANING & CARE

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Clean furniture regularly with a white soft cloth. Gently damp fabrics before cleaning but remember to dry it once you're done.
- Clean spills and stains immediately with a clean cloth. If you're afraid to wipe up any spills straight away, you should encounter any problems.
- Keep liquids away as they may damage the finishing.
- Avoid harsh cleaning chemicals such as alcohol or gasoline solvents. Avoid using sponges or dirty cloths.
- Cover furniture that isn't being used to protect from dust and ageing.
- Retighten screws and attachments if they loosen.







Braza is a natural material and as such may tarnish over time. This can be brought on through regular use or temperature and environment change. To reduce the look of tarnishing and yet, if your dress is original colour, please use the soft scratch pad to gently rub the affected area and surrounding areas. You can then apply a clear wax or lacquer to protect the brass face again. All products are previously treated with PU lacquers to help reduce the risk of tarnishing.

Exposure

- Use protective coasters and mats for items on the furniture.
- Keep furniture away from intense direct sunlight. Exposure can cause cracks and discoloration.
- Severe changes in temperature and humidity can accelerate ageing. Keep furniture at least 60cm from heating or air conditioning.
- Do not place furniture near open flames.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Upon receiving your product, you might find that the door doesn't align well. This note product is flat and can be adjusted to follow the instructions below.
