Assembly



CAUTION: Assemble on a flat surface. Make sure the surface is free of debris or the cabinet is protected. A piece of cardboard is recommended to keep the product from being scratched during assembly.




CAUTION: Please wear gloves during the whole assembling process to avoid accidental personal injury.



CAUTION: For component with protective film, please peel off the protective film before assembling it.


1 TAKE OUT ALL THE HARDWARE

- □ Lay the back of the cabinet down on even floor.
- □ Take the keys put in the bag together with the Instruction Manual to unlock and open the Cabinet doors.
- □ Take out the Hardware package from the inside of the folded cabinet.
- □ Close the doors and make sure it is locked securely.



2 INSTALL THE ADJUSTABLE FEET

Install the Adjustable feet to the bottom of the cabinet.

3 TAKE OUT ALL THE HARDWARE




CAUTION: Use at least two adult to move, assemble or install this product. Failure to do so can result in personal injury or product damaged.




CAUTION: Do not put your hands on the folding point to avoid personal injury.

- Lift the cabinet upwards. Be careful as the cabinet can be slipped or fallen down which may cause serious injury or product damaged.
- Unfold the cabinet case. Do not touch on the conjunction parts while folding to avoid getting injured.





Unfold the Cabinet case totally



4 SETTLE THE BOTTOM PANEL

- Push the side panels till they get flattern. Make sure you adjust the Levelers evenly with the floor.
- □ Unlock the security pin of the Bottom panel.
- Flip down and fix the bottom panel firmly on the base frame of the cabinet.






Flip down the bottom panel Fix the bottom panel firmly


5 INSTALL THE DECK

- Insert the two lower pins on the inner back side of side panels at desired height. Make sure the 2 pins are secured firmly.
- Flip the deck foreward and make sure the 4 pins of the deck are at the same height.
- □ Lock the 2 front pins under the deck and make sure that the pins are secured firmly.



6 INSTALL THE CABINET TOP

- □ Place the wooden surface on top of the cabinet.
- $\hfill\Box$ Make sure to match the position.
- Tighten the 4 screws on the inside of the cabinet, just below the top of the cabinet.



Maintenance

- Check all the screws and nuts periodically for tightness. Tighten them when necessary.
- Check the safety strap periodically for tightness. Tighten it when necessary.

Care and Cleaning

- Periodically clean the surfaces with soft rag and water.
- Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning fluits. For safety, use a nonflamable cleaning fluid.
