Pairing for the First Time

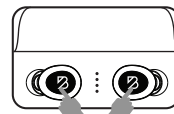
- 1) Remove the protective plastic from the bottom of the earbuds
- 2) Place the earbuds in the charging case until you see a white light
- 3) Remove both earbuds from the charging case and **they will automatically turn on and connect to each other**
- 4) Go to the Bluetooth menu on your device and select "Duet 50 Pro"
- 5) If your phone shows a Bluetooth Pairing Request, press "Pair"

Fixing a Connection Issue

- 1) Go into your phone's bluetooth settings, find "Duet 50 Pro" and click "Forget This Device"
- 2) Place your earbuds in the charging case
- 3) Press and hold the buttons on both earbuds for **5 full seconds** until you see the lights on the earbuds double-flash
- 4) Remove the earbuds from the case
- 5) Turn your phone's Bluetooth off, then on again. Then you should see "Duet 50 Pro" as a discoverable device in your phone's Bluetooth menu.

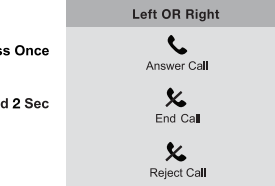

Enter Pairing Mode

When the earbuds are not connected to any device, they will automatically go into pairing mode.

To connect to a new device for the first time, just disconnect your earbuds from your previous device and they will go into pairing mode. Then your new device will be able to discover the earbuds.

Positioning

Place the earphone in your ear with the logo facing out. Rotate the earbud until you find a comfortable position

GREAT FIT = GREAT BASS

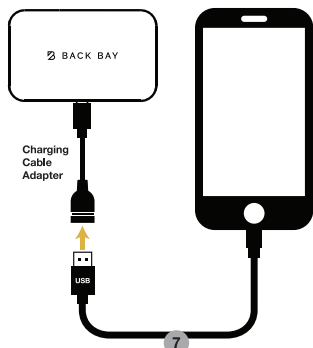

Charging a Phone

Plug a USB-C charging cable directly into the charging case
OR
Locate the charging adapter cable in your accessories box. Plug it into the case, and plug your standard USB charging cable into the open port

How to Charge

Charging the Earbuds

- Simply place the earbuds in the charging case
- When the earbuds are charging, a white light will shine on the earbuds
- When the earbuds are fully charged, the light will turn off
- The case will recharge the earbuds 15 full times

Charging the Case

- Use the USB cable included with your earbuds to connect the USB port on the back of the charging case to a power source

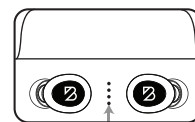
Do not use a charger that exceeds 5V 1A. A higher-powered charger may damage the battery

Charging Status

The LED lights on the inside of the case will shine to show the battery status when you plug in the case or place the earbuds in the case

Battery 100%-75%	4 Lights
Battery 75%-50%	3 Lights
Battery 50%-25%	2 Lights
Battery 25%-0%	1 Light
