








Safety

- Assign a mounting location that will not obstruct driver in any circumstances. Or cause injuries to drivers and passengers in case emergency brake or accidents.
- Ensure all wires are connected properly, and that the unit is functioning well before fitting the unit into the mount
- Any unauthorized installation and modification may cause malfunction to the unit. Always use the parts that are included with the units only.
- Consult authorized dealer if installation requires modifications on the vehicle.
- Unit might not be able to deliver optimum performance in the installation angle exceeds 30° of vertical view.

Opening


This unit can be installed in any dashboard having an opening as shown below:




Installing the unit

Be sure you test all connections first, and then follow these steps to install the unit.


- 1. Make sure the ignition is turned off, and then disconnect the cable from the vehicle battery's negative (-) terminal.
- 2. Disconnect the wire harness and the antenna.
- 3. Mount the sleeve by inserting the sleeve into the opening of the dashboard and bend open the tabs located around the sleeve with a screw driver.
- 4. Make appropriate adjustment on tabs such as bending or adjusting them in order to fit the sleeve perfectly into the dashboard.





- 5. Reconnect the wire harness and the antenna and avoid applying pressure on any wires.
- 6. Slide the unit into the sleeve until in locks into places.
- 7. To further secure the unit, use the supplied metal strap to secure the back of the unit in place. Use the supplied hardware (Hex Nut (M5mm) and Spring Washer) to attach one end of the strap to the mounting bolt on the back of the unit. If necessary, bend the metal strap to fit your vehicle's mounting area. Then use the supplied hardware (Tapping Screw (5x25mm) and Plain Washer) to attach the other end of metal strap to a solid metal part of the vehicle under the dashboard. This strap also helps ensure proper electrical grounding of the unit.

Note: Install the short threading terminal of the mounting bolt to the back of the unit and the other long threading terminal to the dashboard.



8. Reconnect the cable to the vehicle battery's negative (-) terminal. Then replace the outer trim ring.

Removing the unit

- 1. Ensure the ignition is turned off, then disconnect the cable from the vehicle battery's negative (-) terminal.
- 2. Remove the metal strap attached the back of the unit (if attached).
- 3. Lift the top of the outer trim ring then pull it out to remove it.
- 4. Insert both of the supplied keys into the slots at the middle left and right sides of the unit, then pull the unit out of the dashboard.

TURN ON/OFF THE UNIT

Press (18) on the panel to turn on the unit. Press and hold to turn off the unit

PANEL RELEASE

Press (1) on the panel to remove the panel from the main unit.

SOUND ADJUSTMENT

Press **SEL** (13) on the panel to select the preferred mode. The adjustment mode will change in the following order:

TA VOL – AF – TA – BAS – TRE – BAL – FAD – LOUD – EQ LOC – STEREO – EON DX – TA VOL – BEEP – VOL

AF : Alternative frequenciesTA : Traffic announcement

BAS : BassTRE : TrebleBAL : BalanceFAD : Fader

LOUD : LoudnessEQ : Equalization

LOC : LocalDX : Distance


• EON: Enhance other network

Rotate audio knob (13) to adjust sound quality setting.

MAIN MENU

Press (18) on the panel to turn on the unit. Screen will display below main menu



Select option by rotating the audio knob (13), then press **ENT** (13) to select and enter.

In any mode, press and hold to turn off the unit. Or press and hold **ENT** to enter main menu display.

RADIO OPERATION

Switch to

Press **MODE** (15) to select radio. And the following screen will appear



Select Frequency Band

Press **BAND** (6) on the panel to select the desired band. The band reception will change according to following order

For two wave bands:

–->FM1 -> FM2 -> FM3 ->AM1 (MW1) -> AM2 (MW2) -> ¬

Select Station

Press (5) or → (7) on the panel to activate the automatic station search function. It will search up/down stations automatically. Press and hold either button until **MANU** appear on the display, this show manual tuning mode is selected. This mode allow tuning from one to next frequencies until station found. It will tune into the nearest frequency's station if the searching idled for more than 5 seconds.

Manually Store Station & Recall Preset Station

Press and hold any number key on the remote control to store selected station. The corresponding preset number keys allow immediate tune-in to the saved stations.

Automatic Memory Storing & Program Scanning

Automatic Memory Storing

Press and hold AMS button on the remote control, the unit will search from the start of the frequency to the end to test signal strength. Strong signal stations will be store in the corresponding preset number.

Program Scanning

Press AMS button to scan preset stations. The unit will hold at preset number for several second, press MUTE to release to resume searching.

• RDS (Radio Data System) Operation

Setting RDS mode:

Press **AF/EQ** on the remote control to switch on/off RDS mode. **SEL** menu also allow same on/off function.

When RDS is switched on, symbol **AF** will appear on the display.

Program name will be displayed on stored RDS station.

AF starts blinking if the broadcasting signal connection weaken.

ALARM will be displayed when an emergency broadcast is received. Volume level will be adjusted to the preset level automatically when the volume control is set as minimum.

Listening To Traffic Announcement

Press **O/TA** on the remote control to turn on/off the **TA** function. Or select TA in **SEL** menu. Rotate the audio knob to switch on/on the TA function.

When **TA** mode is on and traffic announcement is transmitted:

The unit will switch to temporary radio mode even if the existing mode is USB/SD/DISC or AUX IN.

Temporary switch to **EON** linked station when **EON** detects a traffic announcement on the other program. Volume level will be adjusted to threshold point if the level is below the average point.

When **TA** mode is on, **TA** of individual segment will be turned on. If **TP** station is received, **TP** of individual segment will be turned on.

• TA Interruption Function

The current traffic announcement can be cancelled by turning off the TA function. Received EON TA information can be switched to EON linked station. Information cannot be received if EON linked station is located too far from the signal receiving area and will resume to playing station. If customer is listening to a wrong program or mute sound for awhile, the RDS data used are the PI, PS, AF, TP, TA, EON, and PTY data.

PI: Program identification code for identifying programs.

PS: Program service name broadcast station name data presented in alphanumerical characters.

AF: Alternative frequencies. Frequency list of broadcast ing stations transmitting the same program.

TP: Traffic program identification. Identification data for traffic information-broadcasting station.

TA: Traffic announcement identification.

Identification data showing traffic information is being transmitted or otherwise.

EON: Enhanced other network information. Broadcasting information of PI, AF, TP, TA etc related to networks other than the network in-used for current reception.

Using PTY To Select Program

PTY has a speech group and music group. Press PTY to change as below

PTY Speech – PTY Music – PTY Off

In speech of music group, rotate the volume knob to select the desired PTY. It will search automatically if left idled.



SETTING

In main menu, select **Setting** Icon and press **ENT** to enter below setting menu, use volume knob to select and press **ENT** to enter:



SOUND SETTING



Press ENT to select, then adjust with volume knob: BAS / TRE / BAL / FAD

Press **ENT** to select, then adjust with volume knob: BAS / TRE / BAL / FAD

DISPLAY QUALITY SETTING



Press **ENT** to select, then adjust with volume knob: BRI / CON / CHR / SHA

TIME SETTING



Press **ENT** to select, then adjust with volume knob: Years – Month – Date – Hour – Minute – Time format – Format date

AREA SETTING



Select desired country by rotating volume knob. Note: Press and hold ENT to return to previous interface.

RESET FUNCTION

RESET button can be easily activated with either a sharp end object or a ballpoint pen. Users are advised to reset the unit when following situation occur:

- After installation is completed.
- Function buttons failed to operate.
- · Error message or symbol on the display.

Note: In case reset button cannot be activated, clean the front panel socket with cotton swab that contains isopropyl alcohol.

DISC OPERATION (DVD/VCD/CD/MP3)

Load / Eject Disc

Press <u>A</u> button on the panel to remove the front panel to get access to the disc slot. Insert the disc with printed side facing up into the disc slot (21). Media will be played automatically.

Pause & Play

Press >/II on the remote control to pause the playing media. And press again to continue to play media. Same method even when on DVD/VCD/SVCD.

Press **STOP** on the remote control twice to stop the playing media and return to start-up logo.

• Fast Forward / Fast Rewind

Press ◀ or ▶ on the remote control while media playing. Each press on this button will fast forward/reverse when playing DVD/VCD/CD/MP3. The speed sequence is as following:

 Γ -> Normal playback -> x2 -> x4 -> x8 -> x20 -> Γ

Skip Track

Press (44 or >>) on the remote control or front panel while playing media to skip to the next track or skip to previous track.

Note: Skip track may not be available for all VCD2.0 with PBC on.

DVD Video Menu Play

- 1. Press **TITLE** on the remote control while media playing to go to the TITLE MENU. The disc will play automatically and stop at MENU display.
- 2. Press ▶ ◀ ▲ ▼ on the remote control to move between option bars in the menu.
- 3. Press OK on the remote control to confirm selection.

Repeat Play

Press **RPT** to select different repeat modes. Different repeat mode will apply on different disc.

DVD:

r→ REP [Chapter] → REP [Title] → REP [Off] → ¬

VCD/SVCD/CD/MP3/WMA:

 Γ ->REP [REP 1] -> REP [REP AII] -> REP [Off] -> \neg

Note: VCD2.0 with PBC on does not support Repeat feature.

SPECIAL FUNCTIONS FOR DVD

Multi-subtitle Language Function

Press **SUB-T** on the remote control during media playing. The following information will be displayed:



Keep pressing the same button until the preferred language is selected.

Note: Language will vary from one to another and some disc may only contain one subtitle language.

Multi-audio Language Function

Press AUDIO on the remote control during media playing. The following information will be displayed:



Keep pressing the same button until the preferred language is selected.

Note: Language will vary from one to another and some disc may only contain one soundtrack language.

ZOOM FUNCTION


Press **ZOOM** on the remote control to toggle scale from 1, 2, 3, 4, 1/2, 1/3 to 1/4. When the scale is 1/4, press ZOOM again to exit zoom function.

Use ▶ ◀▲▼ to move up/down/left/right during **zoom** mode to view certain zoomed angle.

GOTO FUNCTION

DVD:

Press **GOTO** on the remote control. The following information will be displayed:



Use number keys to insert the desired Title, Chapter or time, then press OK on the remote control to confirm.

DVD SETUP

Press **SETUP** during media playing or stopped on the remote control to enter **SETUP** menu.

- 1. Use ▶ ◀ on the remote control to move between pages.
- 2. Use ▼ to move the cursor down to the setup page below, then use ▲ ▼ to move between the setup
- 3. options.

Press ▶ to display more selections from the setup option, then press ▲▼ to move between the selections before pressing **OK** to confirm the selection.

SYSTEM SETUP



ON-SCREEN DISPLAY FUNCTION

Press **DISP** on remote control during media playing to display the consoled information of current disc.

USB/SD PLAY

USB is located on front panel. Access SD card slot by removing the front panel. The unit will read media automatically.

If disc is inserted during USB/SD media playing, unit will automatically read disc instead.

Press **STOP** on remote control to stop or on remote control / front panel to pause/play.

- 1. The unit only support standard USB/SD approved by Microsoft.
- 2. USB MP3 file may vary from one to another, unit may not be able to support all the files.
- 3. Remove MP3 player battery when connecting to USB port.

AUX OPERATION

A 3.5mm jack is located on the front panel. Press **MODE** to switch to AUX mode after connecting portable audio player to unit.

EQUALIZATION

Press **EQ** (4) on the front panel to select preset band. Press and hold **AF/EQ** on the remote to select the desire preset band. The band option are as following:

->FLAT -> CLASSIC -> POP -> ROCK -> JAZZ -> EQ OFF

MUTE

In radio, DVD, AUX mode, press **MUTE** on remote control to mute audio output. Press again to resume audio output.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

- Before using Bluetooth function, make sure mobile phone supports Bluetooth function and that the function is turned on.
- Different mobile phone model will produce different Bluetooth emission power. To get the best conversation quality, it is recommended that the distance between the mobile phone and the unit is not further than 3 meter.

PAIRING

- Turn on Bluetooth setting of mobile phone. (Please refer to the instruction manual of your mobile phone on how to operate Bluetooth setting.
- "Car Kit" should appear in the list on your mobile phone Bluetooth device scanning. After selecting "Car Kit", key in "0000" when it requests for device synchronization password.

Press **1/PAU** of the unit front panel to pause/play song. Press **I**◀◀ or ▶►**I** to select next or previous song.















Wiring Connection



Attention:

- 1. Make sure "B+" and "ACC" pin locations are correct before installation. These two pins may vary from one vehicle to another. Wrong connection will lead to burnt fuse.
- 2. "Parking" wire must be connected to the "Ground" in order to activate video function.
- 3. The unit applies to 12V DC cathode ground electrical system only.
- 4. Don't connect the terminals of the car battery until the wires are correctly connected.
- 5. Please make sure to connect yellow wire to the positive side of the battery (+).
- 6. Please make sure specification are similar to the existing fuse in case of replacement.
- 7. Use high quality speaker with impedance of 4 8 ohms for better sound effect.

Troubleshoot

Before going through the checklist, check wiring connection. If any of the problem continues after checklist has been made, consult an authorized dealer.
