MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE

Make sure the on-off switch is off and unplug the power plug when cleaning the hair dryer.

Please regularly use towel, cotton swab or toothbrush to remove the attachment of air inlet and outlet regularly.

Do not press or rub the air inlet and outlet with nails or sharp objects to avoid damaging the product.

Do not use alcohol, nail washing water or detergent to clean this product, otherwise it may cause failure, cracking or fading.

PRODUCT SAFETY CAUTIONS

In order to reduce the risk of failure, electric shock, injury, fire, death and damage to equipment or property, be sure to observe the following safety precautions

Power cord and power plug

- On Do not use when the power cord or plug is damaged or heated, otherwise it may cause scald, electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- On not use when the power plug is loose, otherwise it may cause scald, electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- O Do not unplug the power plug when your hands are wet, otherwise it may cause electric shock and injury.
- O Do not use it when the power cord is tied, otherwise it may cause electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- On not damage, modify, bend, pull, twist the power cord, place heavy objects on the power cord, or squeeze the power cord, otherwise it may cause electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- ① When unplugging the power plug, do not pull the power cord. Be sure to pull it out by holding the power plug, otherwise the power cord may be disconnected, scald, electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- ① Fully insert the power plug; Please use 120V voltage; Please use the socket alone and do not use the power terminal block, otherwise it may cause electric shock or fire due to short circui.
- ① If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by professionals of the manufacturer, its maintenance department or similar departments in order to avoid danger.

Use and storage

- O Do not use the hair dryer in the bathroom, otherwise it may cause electric shock, even after the on-off switch is disconnected.
- On Do not place the air inlet of the hair dryer downward in the working state, otherwise it may cause the heating wire to turn red and cause a fire.
- On not block or insert foreign matters into the air outlet and air inlet, otherwise it may cause scald, electric shock or fire due to high temperature or short circuit.
- Do not cover the air inlet and outlet with towels and clothes, otherwise it may cause scald, electric shock or fire due to high temperature or short circuit
- The hair dryer is only designed for hair blowing function. Do not use the hair dryer for dry clothes and other non designed uses.
- O Do not immerse the hair dryer in water.
- O Do not use this hair dryer in a humid environment.
- O Please keep the hair dryer dry, otherwise it may cause electric shock.
- O Do not use with wet hands, otherwise electric shock or fire may occur due to short circuit.
- On not use near LPG or other inflammable products (such as volatile agents, paint thinners, sprays, etc.), otherwise it may cause explosion or cause a fire due to short circuit.
- O Do not leave the product with the power on, otherwise fire may be caused by short circuit.
- On not wrap the power cord around the main body of the product during storage, otherwise the power cord may be disconnected, electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- On not store it in a highly humid place, otherwise it may cause electric shock or fire due to short circuit.

In case of abnormality or failure




Operation instructions

- ♦ In the process of using, the air outlet and nozzle may become hot. Do not touch them with your hands, otherwise they may cause burns.
- OPlease avoid dropping the hair dryer or strong impact on the hair dryer, otherwise it may cause electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- OPlease do not use it when the air inlet is damaged, otherwise the hair may be drawn into the air inlet, resulting in hair damage.
- O Please do not use it on infants, otherwise it may cause burns.
- O Please do not store the power cord when it is twisted, otherwise it may cause the power cord to break, scald, electric shock or fire due to short circuit.
- This product is only used to dry hair. Do not use it to dry shoes and clothes, otherwise it may cause scald or fire due to short circuit.

During the useage, do not touch the net on the air outlet of the hair dryer to avoid scalding.



Please ensure that the hair is kept more than 30cm away from the air inlet when using the hair dryer to avoid the hair being drawn into the hair dryer. Please ensure that the hair is kept more than 10cm away from the air outlet to avoid hair burns.




- 1. The hair dryer is equipped with 30min automatic power-off protection. When the hair dryer works continuously for 30min without operation, it will automatically stop working, so as to avoid forgetting to shut down or mistakenly touching the start, resulting in the long-term operation of the machine without adult monitoring. To continue using please restart.
- 2. The blower is equipped with overheating automatic power-off protection. When the blower temperature is too high, it will automatically stop operation. In this case, please turn off the power supply of the hair dryer immediately. And remove the power plug from the power socket, and check whether the air inlet and outlet are blocked by hair or foreign matters. If there is no foreign matter, restart the power switch after the blower is cooled for 2 ~ 3 minutes; If there are foreign matters, please contact the after-sales customer service immediately. Do not operate by yourself.
- 3. The telescopic rod of the hair dryer is connected and fixed with the base through a coupler. When shaking the hair dryer by hand, it will shake slightly, which is a normal phenomenon. Please set your mind at rest to use
- 4. The illustrations of products and accessories in the manual are schematic diagrams for reference only. Due to the update and upgrade of the product, the physical product may be slightly different from the schematic diagram. Please take the physical product as the standard

1, installation.




2. Insert the power plug into the socket.



3. Adjust the angle of the hair dryer head according to the rotation direction shown in the figure.






4. Adjust the height of supporting rod.

6. Use the four buttons on the outer ring of remote control to adjust the hair dryer.


Please be careful not to press the OFF button.






NOTE: If the hair dryer is not powered on ,please check whether the rod and the base are well connected.

PRODUCT FEATUREA


- 1. The standing hair dryer can be directly used for 120V, 60Hz power supply and has five grades to adjust temperature and other different heat modes, to meet various needs.

ABNORMAL STATUS OPERATION GUIDE

INSTRUCTION FOR BACK UP BUTTON

If the remote controller does not work, the back up button can be used to start the hair dryer in emergancy.

Double click back up button to start, it goes directly into Hot Mode, then click, it goes into Cool Mode, next click, it will be off.





REMOTE CONTROLLER RE-CONNECT

Please re-connect the remote controller if the product is under following situation:

1.Back up button is on a red light and the remote controller has electricity, but can not control the hair dryer.

- Prepare: make sure that the hair dryer is powered on.
- Press and hold the back up button 3 seconds, then I Now press the OFF button. you will hear a beep, now you can release your hand, the blue light is flashing.
- When the indicator light changes from flashing blue to stable blue or off, it is complete.









The blue light is always on or off. the pairing is completed.

THE INSTRUCTIONS OF REMOTE CONTROLLER **BATTERY REPLACEMENT**

Please replace the battery in the following ways:

- Use a screwdriver to turn counterclockwise to open the rear cover.
- Remove the remote control battery and replace a new one. When installing the battery, please note "+" is upward.
- · Screw in the rear cover clockwise.





Note: When the battery is replaced, if the remote controller can not control the hair dryer, please re-connect with the main body.
