Assembly and Repair of the Massage Chair

Power Plug and Cord

- Check that the Attendating Current (AC) valtage corresponds with the specifications, indicated for the massage chair.
- Do not connect or disconnect the power plug from the electrical outlet with wethonos.

- When disconnecting the power plug, pull a by holding the alog, not the cord.
- Although operation will be stopped advantatioally when the timerends, always remember to switch off the main power switch after use.
- Do not place the power cord under the massage and not any other heavy objects.
- Do not wind the power cord around the massage chair as this may camage the card and result in a fire or electric shock.

Grounding Instructions


- This product must be grounded. If it should malfund, on a breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric conent reduce the risk of electric shock.

- The plug must be pugged into an appropriate each calculate, that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.






Moving the Chair

- Cover the floor with a mat when moving the massage chair to prevent domoging the floor.






Ensure that there is an allowance of more than 5cm, behind the massage chair and more than 25cm in front of the massage chair to allow the bookrest to realine without abstraction.





- Dipla soft, dry clain in water or worm water containing 3% to 5% nectral detergent and wring it thoroughly.
- 3. Wipe the leather and plastic components with the damp claim.
- 4. Wipe the components with a soft dry clotha
- 5. Let it dry naturally.

Warning

- Do not use alcohol, crimner, gospline and other chemicals for deching.
- Do not dry the surface with a form hairdryer. Allow it to dry not urally.
- Boingt ron the fabric.
- Boring maintenance, always unplug the power plug. Do not criplagit, with wet hairds.
- Place a dust cover over the chair filt won't be used for a long time to avoid post buildings.
- Wipe the product, with the metahine formic oped in middlebergent if the dirt is hard to remove.
- Woter temperature should not exceed 40°.
- Be cauchous when asing denim or coloured claim to wipe the product as the fabric's dye may bonsfer to the leather.
- Avoid letting the leather come into contact with plastic to prevent colour feding.


