


#### **INSTALLING BEAR EAR SPEAKERS**

Align the tabs on the BEAR EAR SPEAKERS with the slots on the headphones (the tabs are keyed so they will only insert in one orientation), insert and twist to secure as shown in Figure 1.




#### **REMOVING BEAR EAR SPEAKERS**

Twist the BEAR EAR SPEAKERS and remove as shown in Figure 2.



#### CHANGING DIRECTION OF BEAR EAR SPEAKERS

Twist the BEAR EAR SPEAKERS to change the direction of the speakers as shown in Figure 3.



#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Spot clean with a soft, dry cloth.

### ONE (1) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY
