


- 0. Make sure that the Mighty Amp App is installed on your iOS device.
- 1. Unlock your iOS divice.
- 2. Open iTunes on your Windows PC.
- 3. Connect your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch to your computer using the USB cable that came with your device, and make sure to **Trust** "Trust This Computer?"
- 4. Click your device in iTunes. Get help if you can't find it.

- 6. Select the Mighty Amp app




4. Drag and drop your music file/files to the **Mighty Amp Documents** folder.




5. Close iTunes, and disconnect the iOS device from your Windows PC, then unplug the USB cable.

6. Tap the Mighty Amp App on your iOS device to open the app, go to the **JamTrack** page - tap the **Custom** button, all your imported music files are listed below.




7. Tap the Edit button and start adding events to your custom music, tap the save button to save your events.



- 5. A file transfer window will open on your computer, locate the **Music** Folder.




6. Drag and drop your music file/files to the **Music** Folder.




- 7. When you're done, eject your phone from Windows.
