## WARNING

- TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK, DO NOT REMOVE COVER. THERE ARE NO SERVICEABLE PARTS INSIDE.
- TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE OR ELECTRIC SHOCK, DO NOT EXPOSE THIS UNIT TO RAIN OR MOISTURE.



The lightning flash with arrow-head symbol within an equilateral triangle is intended to alert the user to the presence of uninsulated "dangerous voltage" within the unit's enclosure that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock.



The exclamation point within an equilateral triangle is intended to alert the user to the presence of important operating and maintenance (servicing) instructions in the literature accompanying the unit.

## **DANGER**

To reduce the risk of electric shock, burns, fire or injury:

1. Always unplug the unit from the electrical outlet immediately after using.
2. Do not use while bathing or in a shower.
3. Do not place or store unit where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
4. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
5. Do not reach for unit that has fallen into water. Unplug it immediately.
6. Care should be taken so that objects do not fall and liquids are not spilled, splashed or dripped onto the unit.
7. Do not place objects filled with liquid, such as vases, on the unit.
8. Caution, excessive sound pressure from earphones and headphones can cause hearing loss.
9. Turning off the main switch does not completely disconnect power. Unplug unit directly from power outlet when not in use.

# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

All of the safety and operating instructions should be read, heeded, adhered to and followed before the unit is operated.

## CAUTION

### CARTS AND STANDS

**IMPORTANT:** The appliance should be used only with a cart or stand that is recommended by the manufacturer.

-  1. AN APPLIANCE AND CART COMBINATION SHOULD BE MOVED WITH CARE. Quick stops, excessive force, and uneven surface may cause the appliance and cart combination to overturn.
2. VENTILATION  
The appliance should be situated so that its location or position does not interfere with its proper ventilation. For example, the appliance should not be situated on a bed, sofa, rug or similar surface that may block the ventilation openings; or placed in a built-in installation, such as a bookcase or cabinet, that may impede the flow of air through the ventilation openings.

3. GROUNDING OR POLARIZATION

Do not defeat the safety purpose of this polarized or grounding plug. The polarized plug has two blades, one wider than the other. The grounding plug has two blades plus a third grounding prong. These features are for your safety. DO NOT alter the plug to fit your outlet in any way. Call a qualified electrician to update your obsolete outlet.

4. CLEANING

The appliance should be cleaned only with a soft, dry cloth.

5. POWER LINES

An outdoor antenna should be located away from power lines.

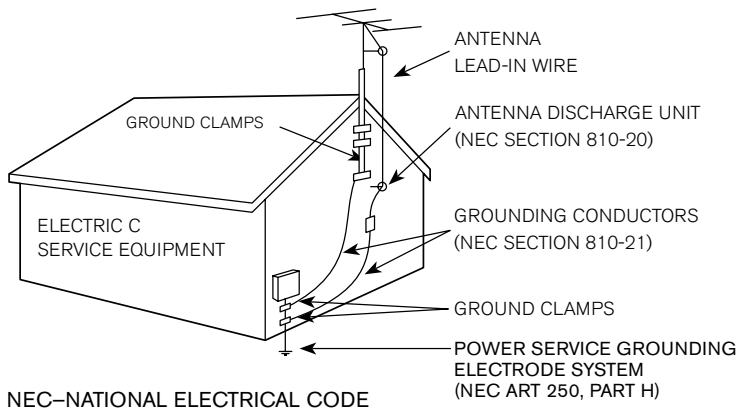
6. OUTDOOR ANTENNA GROUNDING

If an outside antenna is connected to the receiver, be sure the antenna system is grounded so as to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges. Article 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70, provides information with regard to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna-discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna discharge unit, connection to grounding electrodes, and requirements for the grounding electrode. See Figure 1.

## 7. DAMAGE REQUIRING SERVICE

The appliance should be serviced by qualified service personnel when:

- a) The power-supply cord or the plug has been damaged; or
- b) Objects have fallen, or liquid has been spilled into the appliance; or
- c) The appliance has been exposed to rain; or
- d) The appliance does not appear to operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance; or
- e) The appliance has been dropped, or the enclosure damaged.

## 8. SERVICING

The user should not attempt to service the appliance beyond that described in the operating instructions. All other servicing should be referred to qualified service personnel.

9. Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

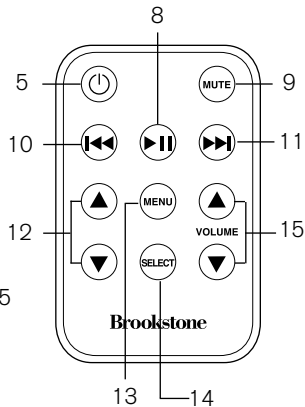

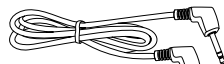

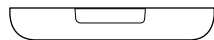

# OPERATION

## TURNING THE UNIT ON/STANDBY

1. Switch the MAIN POWER SWITCH on the back of the unit to ON.
2. Press  on top of the tower or on the remote to turn the unit on.  
The blue POWER LED will illuminate.
3. Press  again to put the unit into STANDBY mode.

**Note:** Your iPod/iPhone will charge while it is docked in the unit in Power On and in Stand-by Mode.

## TURNING OFF THE UNIT

Switch the MAIN POWER SWITCH on the back of the unit to OFF.

## CONNECTING YOUR iPod/iPhone TO THE UNIT

1. Select the correct iPod/iPhone DOCK ADAPTER for your device from the following list, or use the one that came with your iPod/iPhone, and snap it securely into the docking area on the top of the unit.

**iPod/iPhone DOCK ADAPTERS** included are as follows:

Insert A: iPod classic (160GB (2009), 120GB, 80GB)

Insert B: iPod nano (4th Gen)



Insert C: iPod nano (5th Gen)

Insert D: iPod touch (2nd Gen)

Insert E: iPhone (3G/3GS)

2. Insert your iPod/iPhone into the dock.



## PLAYING AND PAUSING YOUR MUSIC

With your iPod/iPhone docked in the unit, press  on the unit or remote to turn the unit on. iPod/iPhone playback will begin. Press  on the remote to pause playback.



## FAST-FORWARDING AND REWINDING YOUR SONGS

Press and hold  or  on the remote to rewind or fast-forward within a song.

## SKIPPING FORWARD AND BACKWARD TO A SONG

Press and release  or  on the remote incrementally to skip forward or backward to a song.



## ADJUSTING THE VOLUME

Press VOLUME  or  on the remote control or rotate VOLUME KNOB on top of the unit to adjust sound levels.

## MUTING THE SOUND

Press MUTE on the remote to turn off the sound. Press MUTE again to turn the sound back on.

## USING THE iPod/iPhone MENU FEATURE

1. Press MENU on the remote to enter the iPod/iPhone menu.
2. Press SCROLL  or  on the remote to scroll through the functions.
3. Press SELECT on the remote to select a function.

## REMOVING THE SPEAKER GRILLE

Gently pull the speaker grille away from the unit. The speaker grille posts will pull free from the rubber grommets.

## CONNECTING OTHER STEREO COMPONENTS

Connect an MP3 Player to the AUX IN jack using a 3.5mm to 3.5mm cable (included). The unit automatically changes to auxiliary mode. Use your MP3 Player as you normally would.

Note: The Remote Control will not control an MP3 Player in auxiliary mode. Connect the Audio Out terminals of TV, VCR or DVD Player to the AUX IN jack by using audio cords with mini plugs (not included).

## OUTPUTTING SOUND TO OTHER EQUIPMENT/SPEAKERS

Connect the AUX OUT jack on the back of the unit to other equipment or speakers by using audio cords with mini jacks (not included).

# TROUBLESHOOTING

ISSUE	SOLUTION
The remote will not operate the tower.	<p>The batteries are low. Replace the batteries.</p> <p>The IR sensor is blocked. Make sure there are no obstacles in between the remote and the tower, and ensure the speaker grille is mounted in the correct orientation.</p>
There is a "This accessory is not made to work with iPhone" warning on the iPhone when I dock in the speaker.	The speaker needs a few seconds to authenticate the iPhone. Try removing and redocking the iPhone if the warning does not disappear after a few seconds.
