



## **GETTING STARTED:**

Before connecting Alexa to your Automate Pulse 2 account, please ensure your Automate Pulse 2 Hub and shades are working.

Go to your Automate Pulse 2 app and add the Hub following the suggested steps. Afterward, proceed to pair motorized shades through the Pulse 2 App.

To control your shades with Alexa, you will need the following:


- 1. Setup and working Automate Pulse 2 Hub.
- 2. Paired and working shades within the Pulse 2 App.
- 3. Automate Pulse 2 App and account login credentials
- 4. Alexa App and account.

1. In the Alexa App select the **More** page at the bottom. Then select **Skills & Games**.



2. Search Automate Shades v2 at the top and select the Skill.




3. Select Enable to Use and log in.



Enter the email and password associated with your Automate Pulse 2 App you would like to link.

**4.** Select **Continue** to discover Scenes and Devices.



Select a discovered shade and then select Set Up Device to add it to Alexa. Repeat for each of the discovered shades.

## **5.** Test the communication. Simply say:

"Alexa, Open Bottom-Up Roller Shade"



- "Alexa, Close Roman Shade"
- "Alexa, turn on Good Morning"
- "Alexa close the Master Bedroom a little bit"
- "Alexa, set Bedroom Shade to 22%".

## TIPS:

Alexa responds to names created in the Automate Pulse 2 App. Consider using "one" when numbering shades instead of "1". Avoid using all special characters like % and numbers.

If you have changed the name of your shade or scene in your Pulse 2 App, please ensure you force close the Automate Pulse 2 App, then reopen the Pulse 2 App. Only then can you rediscover the devices and scenes in your Alexa App.
