

Dear customer,

Thank you for choosing our product. This manual will provide you with valuable information necessary for the proper care and maintenance of your new product. Please take a few moments to thoroughly read the instructions and familiarize yourself with all the operational aspects of your new fan.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

When using this appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury to persons, including the following:


1. Read all instructions before using this fan.
2. CAUTION: Risk of electric shock. Do not open or try to repair the fan yourself.
3. Never insert foreign objects, such as fingers, pencil, etc. through the grille when fan is running.
4. Always unplug the fan when moving it from one location to another, when cleaning grille or for cleaning.
5. Be sure the fan is in a stable, even position before operating or adjusting settings.
6. Do not use the fan in crowded rooms may create an electrical hazard. Do not leave fan operating adjacent to an area where water is used. There is a real potential of electrical hazard. Do not immerse plug or cord in water or spray with liquids.
7. Do not operate the fan with a damaged cord or plug or after the fan malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Return the fan to authorized service facility for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, as required.
8. Do not operate in the presence of explosive and/or combustible fumes.
9. Do not place fan near an open flame, cooking or other heating appliance.
10. Do not use this fan outdoors or where there are bodies of water, such as the bathroom or laundry room. Never locate fan where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container. Do not stand against electrical cords. DO NOT immerse in water or other liquids.
11. Do not use fan without base. The fan blade(s) can start during startup.
12. Do not use fan over curtain rods, window treatments or where other objects could come in contact with the blades.
13. To disconnect, grip plug and pull from wall outlet. Never yank on cord.
14. Do not use cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic areas and where it will not be tripped over.
15. This appliance is not intended for use by persons including children with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, or less if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
16. In order to ensure your child's safety, please keep all packaging (plastic bags, boxes, plastic containers) out of their reach.
17. If you notice any off odors, extractors cleaned area from the fan, turn the appliance off and unplug it immediately.
18. Use only for intended household use as described in this manual. Any other use not

recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury to persons. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by manufacturer.

19. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person in order to avoid hazard.

ASSEMBLY

Assembly of base

Remove all parts from packing.

1. Set the base on the floor.
2. Unscrew base locking nut from the threaded end of the lower column.
3. Insert the lower column into the center hole of the fan base, put the locking nut onto the threaded end of the lower column and turn it clockwise to secure and tighten the base to the lower column.
4. Turn the base over and set it on the floor.
5. Insert the upper column into the top hole of the base column. Tighten the column securing knob.
6. Place the fan body on the top of the upper column. Tighten the body securing knobs.

Assembly of fan blade and grille

1. Remove and discard the axial sleeve under motor shaft. Fasten the rear grille against the front of the motor housing through the motor shaft. Ensure that the guiding pegs on the motor housing are lined up with cutouts on the rear grille.
2. Screw the rear grille into place with the mounting nut. Fasten the nut firmly onto the motor housing by tightening it clockwise.

1. Screw the fan blade onto the motor shaft and make sure the blades A & B match with the orientation of the motor shaft.
 2. Place blade C onto the main shaft with 1 blade. Fasten into place by tightening the 4-M4 cap counter-clockwise direction (Fig. 6).
 3. Attach the front grille to rear grille by aligning the alignment marks on the top of the grilles, clamping them together by the nuts (a in Fig. 1) on the front grille and the nuts (b in Fig. 1) on the rear grille. (see Fig. 7), rotate the front grille clockwise to the lock position.
- Note: Unscrew the nuts (a) from the front grille before assembly (see Fig. 2).





6. Tighten the lock screw to secure the grilles (see Fig. 1).



7. Check the connection of the fan.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION: Ensure the product is fully assembled before plugging it into a power socket.

1. Place the fan on a flat, level and stable surface.
2. Plug into a 220-240V 50Hz power socket, the assistance will be to stability mode.
3. The assistance may be operated by the push buttons on the control panel or by the supplied remote control.
4. **ON/OFF SETTING**
Press 'ON/OFF' button on top side (or On Off), the fan start running at the default middle speed(F2). Press again to turn the fan off.
5. **SPEED SETTING**
Press 'SPEED' button on the control panel or supplied remote control will cycle the fan through 4 constant speeds(F1-low speed, F2-middle speed, F3-high speed, F4-max speed).
6. **SWING SETTING**
Press 'SWING' button on the control panel or supplied remote control will active the oscillation for widespread air distribution, press twice in a row to stop the oscillation.
7. **TIMER SETTING**
Press 'TIMER' button on control panel or the supplied remote control, sets the timer in increments of 1 hour to a maximum of 8 hours. After the time is counted, the fan will automatically shut off.
8. **HOURS SETTINGS**
Press 'HOURS' button on control panel or the supplied remote control will cycle the fan through different patterns of wind modes.
NORMAL wind: The fan is operating on the normal mode.
NATURAL wind: The fan is simulating a natural wind by cycling through all the speeds.
SLEEP wind: The fan runs in SLEEP mode and decrease by one level per half an hour and can't be lower at low speed, ideal for resting.
• If it is selected HIGH, the fan will work under HIGH NATURAL wind mode for half an hour, then revert to work under MID NATURAL wind mode for half an hour and then revert to LOW NATURAL wind mode.
• If it is selected MEDIUM, the fan will work under MID NATURAL mode for half an hour and then revert to LOW NATURAL wind mode.
• If it is selected LOW, the fan will work under LOW NATURAL wind mode.
9. Unplug the fan when not in use.

REMOTE CONTROLLER INSTRUCTION

1. The remote control includes one CR2025 battery. Battery is not pre-installed.
2. Pull the plastic insulation film out from the backside of the remote control before first use.
3. The remote control function the same as the control panel, on wire. Follow the same instruction above to operate the fan remotely.
4. Note: The remote control must be pointed toward the unit for the fan in order to work.
5. Please take out the battery for long time usage.

WARNING: KEEP NEW AND USED BATTERIES AWAY FROM CHILDREN. The remote control supplied with this product contains a button cell battery. Leaking or damaged batteries can cause burns or contact with skin. The battery could potentially be a choking hazard for children. If the button cell battery is swallowed, it can cause severe internal harm in just 2 hours and can lead to death. If you think the battery may have been swallowed, or placed twice any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention.
DO NOT DISPOSE OF BATTERY IN FIRE. BATTERIES MAY EXPLODE OR LEAK.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

1. Unplug the unit.
2. To keep the fan clean, the outer shell may be cleaned with a soft, damp cloth. You may use a mild detergent if necessary. After cleaning, dry the unit with a soft cloth. **CAUTION:** DO NOT let liquid enter the fan.
3. DO NOT use alcohol, gasoline, abrasive powders, furniture polish, or organic solvents to clean the fan. This may cause damage or deterioration to the surface of the fan.
4. DO NOT immerse the fan in water.
5. Wait until the unit is completely dry before use.
6. Store the heater in a cool, dry location when not in use. To prevent dust and dirt build-up, use the original packing to replace the unit.
