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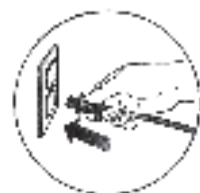

### POLARIZED PLUG:

As a safety feature, this plug will only be positioned into a wall outlet if the plug does not fit fully into the outlet. Reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. **DO NOT** force into outlet or try to modify to fit.

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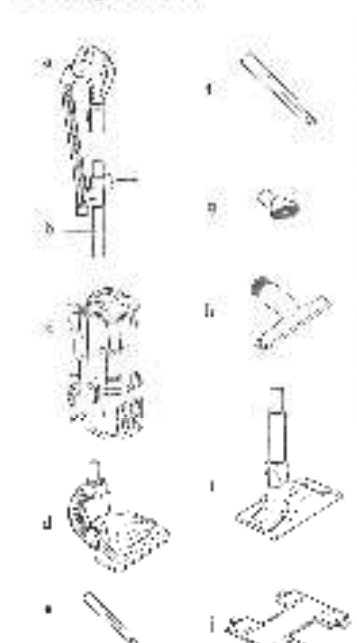

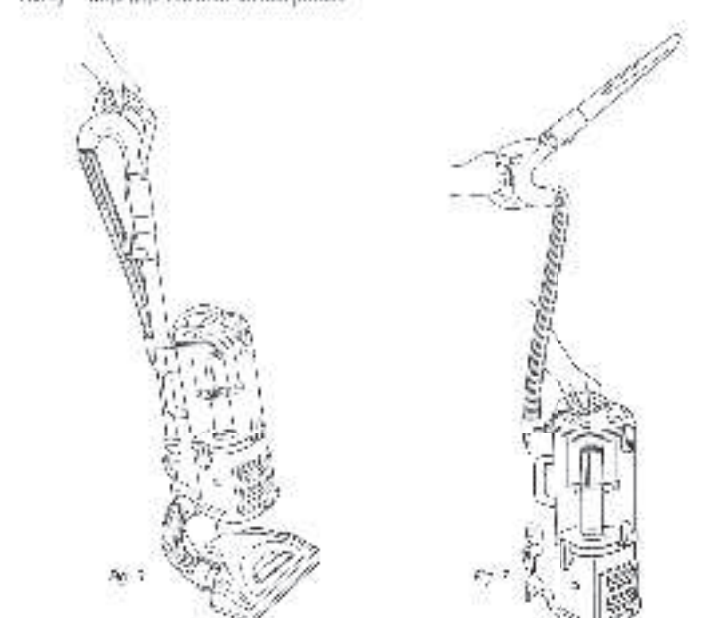

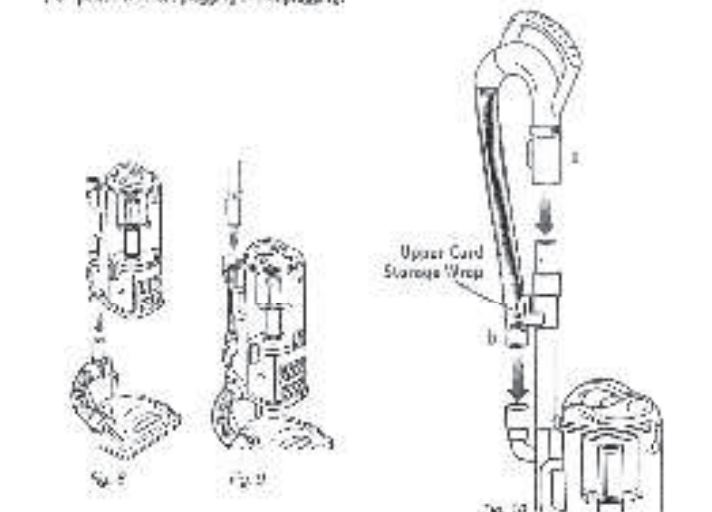
#### MODES:

### Mode 1: Upright Vac

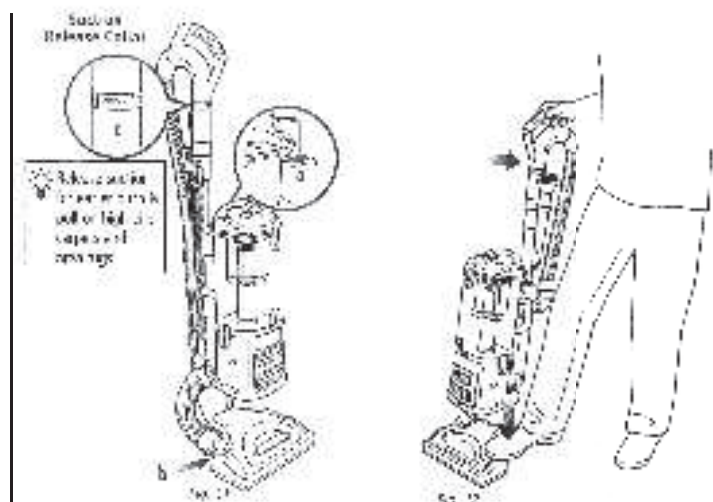

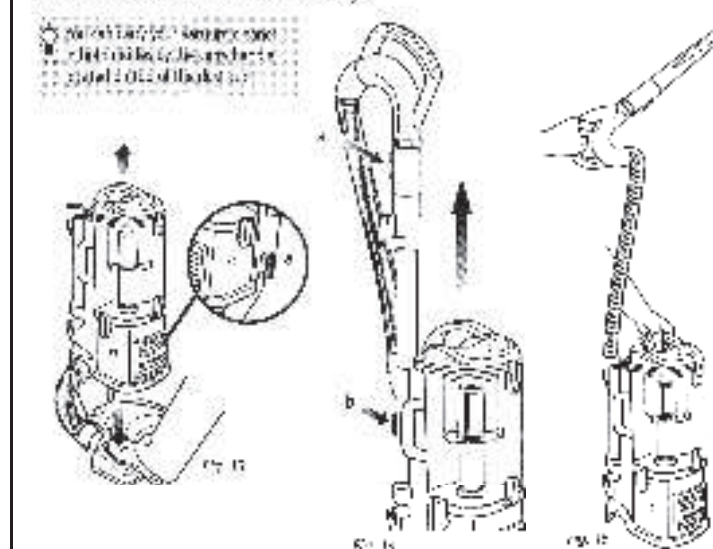
