

Jabra GN8210 Digital audio enhancer

How do I install an amplifier to a Cisco IP telephone?

First check if the Cisco telephone has a RJ9 headset jack. If so, it is advantageous to use this jack for the ease of the call handling process. Follow these installation steps:

- 1. Install the connection cord, that came with the amplifier, from the amplifiers "telephone icon" jack to the Cisco phones' headset jack.
- 2. Install the quick disconnect cord in the amplifiers headset jack and the other appropriate end to the headsets' quick disconnect cord.
- 3. Install batteries (if applicable) into the amplifiers battery compartment or plug in the optional AC power supply.
- 4. With the amplifiers' lid opened, adjust the "battery saving feature" switch (if applicable) and the blue transmit volume knob.
- 5. Below the battery compartment; adjust the compatibility switch to "B" and close the lid.
- 6. Move the headset/handset (or phone/pc) toggle switch to headset/phone mode and make sure the mute toggle switch is not set on mute. As long as the Cisco phone is programmed for headset use; you are now ready to use the headset by pressing the Cisco phones' headset button.

If the Cisco telephone does NOT have a headset jack, follow these installation steps:

- Unplug the Cisco telephone receiver handset cord from the base of the Cisco phone.
- 2. Install the connection cord, that came with the amplifier, from the amplifiers "telephone icon" jack to the Cisco phones' handset jack.
- 3. Install the Cisco telephones handset into the handset icon jack of the





- amplifier and then hang the handset receiver back on the phone.
- 4. Install the quick disconnect cord in the amplifiers headset jack and the other appropriate end to the headsets' quick disconnect cord.
- 5. Install batteries (if applicable) into the amplifiers battery compartment or plug in the optional AC power supply.
- 6. With the amplifiers' lid opened, adjust the "battery saving feature" switch (if applicable) and the blue transmit volume knob.Below the battery compartment; adjust the compatibility switch to "A" and close the lid.
- 7. Move the headset/handset (or phone/pc) toggle switch to headset/phone mode and make sure the mute toggle switch is not set on mute.Lift the Cisco telephone handset receiver off the phone and you should have dialtone in the headset.



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
