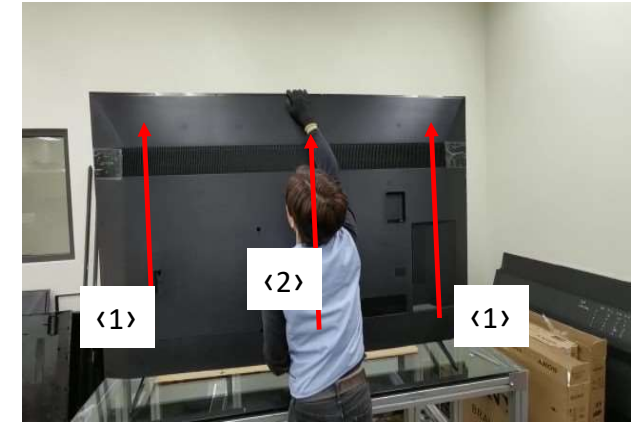

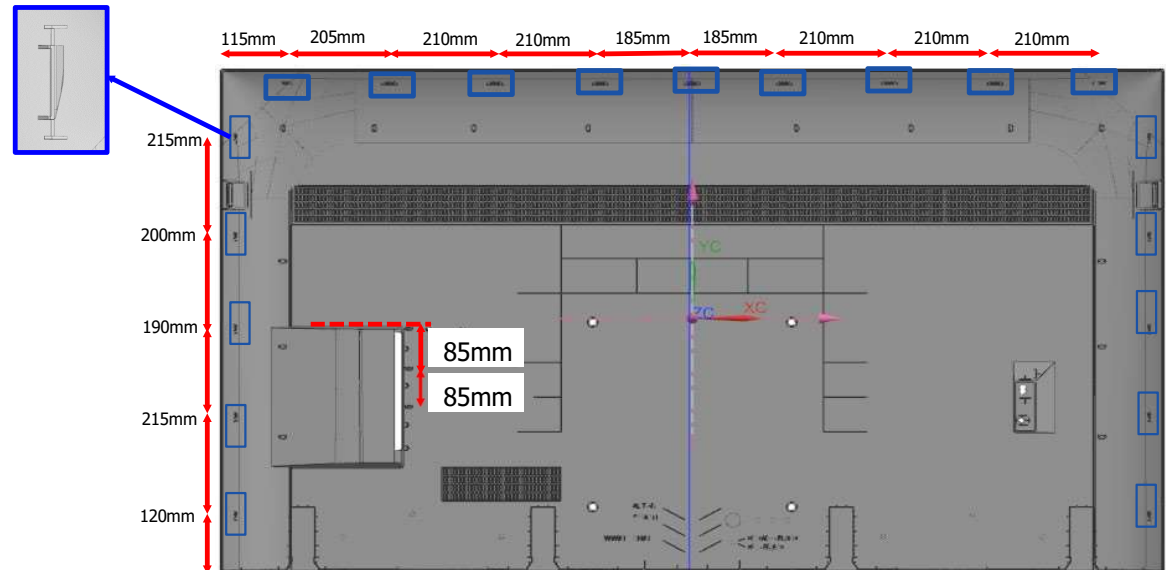

Hook positioning.

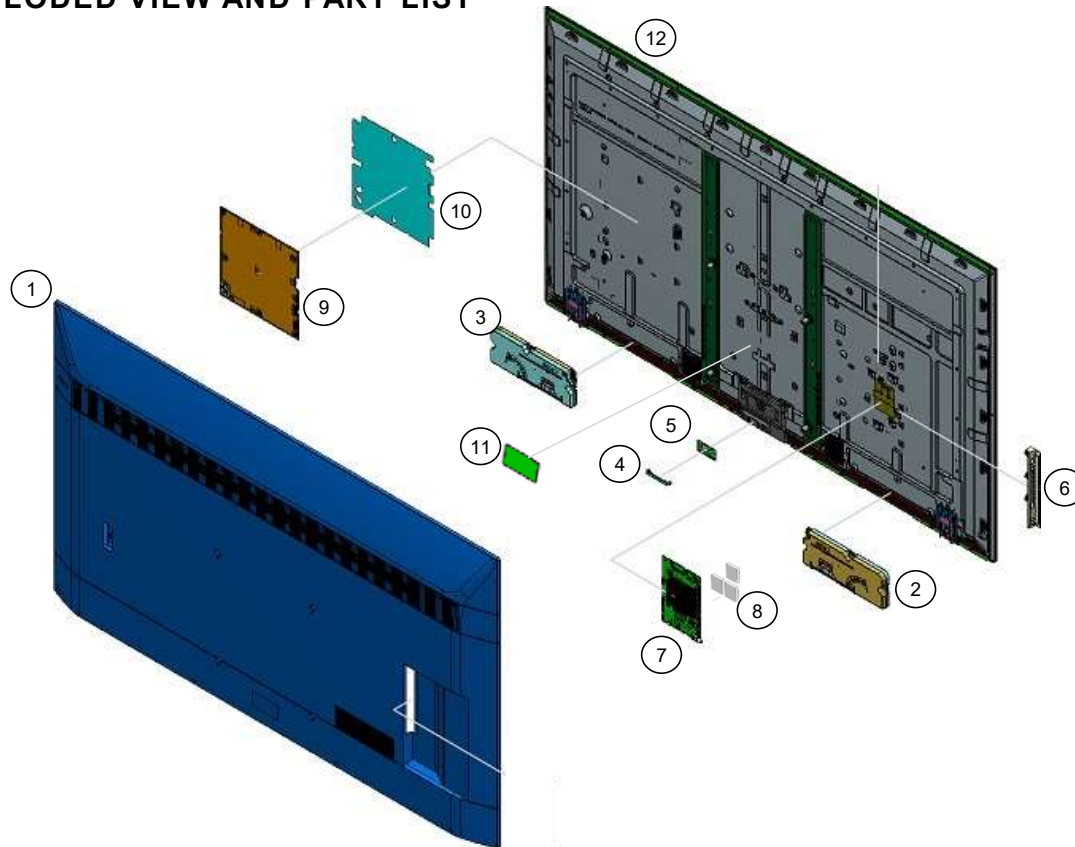

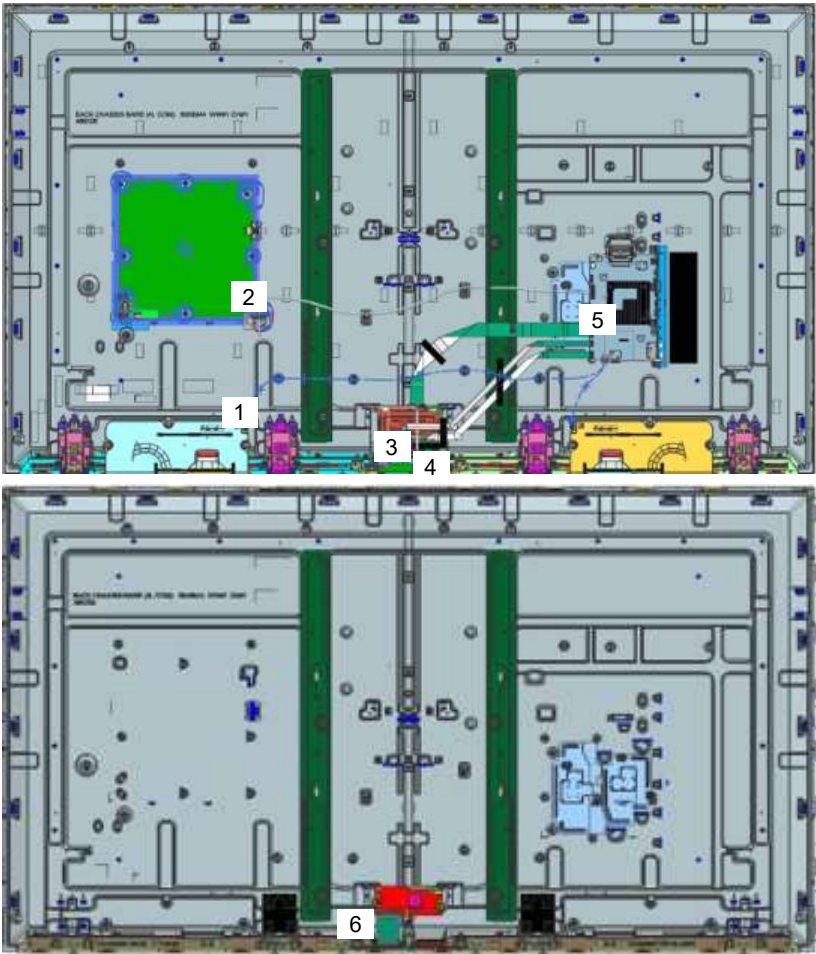
