- respect power cord and plug for any carriage before use DO NOT use vacuum cleaner with a damaged cord or olog. Turn off all controls patigeulanu to all gallegula erotect the vacuum cleaner. Store your vacuum cleaner with the power cord. secured around the two cord hocks. To minimize the risk of power cord annage, do not allow the incorrect prush to little good. If this occurs immediately shut off power to the veguum and remove the bord.
- 2. This appliance has a polarized plug, the prug does not fit fully into the suffer, reverse the plug (one blade is wider than the other). If it still does not rit, contact a qualified electrician. 20 NC | force into putlet or try to modify to fit.


Regularly rinse and replace the filters to maintain your vacuum's suction power.

To prevent parriage from cleaning chemicals, rinse filters with cold water DNLY Allow all filters. to air dry for all east 24 nours before reinstalling them to present liquid from being down into cleating parts.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT use sono when cleaning the fibers.



Vacuum turns off on its own or indicator light flashes red.

If your vacuum overheats, the thermostat will automatically turn off the motor. Follow these

steps to restart: Turn vacuum orf and unplug it.

- Empty dust cup and clean filters (see Emptying the Dust Cup and Cleaning Filters).
- Check for blocktiges in base, wand, norzle, accessóries, and infet openings.
- Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 60 minutes.
- Picg in vacuum and turn it on.


