Update instructions

This unit is equipped with a function to update the firmware via network or USB port.

How to Check Firmware

Press the "settings" button on the remote controller, and refer to "Miscellaneous" - "Firmware Update" - "Version"

Updating Firmware Via Network

1. Press the "settings" button on the remote. The Setup menu should then be displayed on the TV screen.
2. Select "Miscellaneous" - "Firmware Update" - "Update via NET" with the cursors in order, then press ENTER.
3. Press ENTER with "Update" selected to start the update.
4. Press ON/STANDBY on the main unit (not the remote) to turn the unit into standby mode. Once this is done, the process is complete.

Updating Firmware via USB

1. Connect the USB storage device to your PC.
2. Download the firmware file from the our company's website to your PC and unzip.
Firmware files are named as below.
ONKAVR****_R***.zip Unzip the file on your PC.
The number of unzipped files and folders varies depending on the model.
3. Copy all unzipped files and folders to the root folder of the USB storage device.
4. Connect the USB storage device to the USB port of this unit.
5. Press "settings". Select "Miscellaneous" - "Firmware Update" - "Update via USB" with the cursors in order, then press ENTER.
6. Press ENTER with "Update" selected to start the update.
7. Disconnect the USB storage device from the unit.
8. Press ON/STANDBY on the main unit (not the remote) to turn the unit into standby mode. The process is completed, and your firmware is updated to the latest version.
