Product Usage Instructions

Getting Started

To use the Ener001 replacement remote control, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Remove the old batteries from the original remote control.
- 2. Insert new batteries (not included) into the Ener001 replacement remote control, ensuring correct polarity.
- 3. Aim the replacement remote control towards the device you want to control.

Basic Functions

The Ener001 replacement remote control provides various basic functions:

Button	Function	
Power	Turns the device on or off	
Mute	Mutes or unmutes the device's audio	
Volume+	Increases the volume	
Volume-	Decreases the volume	
Channel+	Selects the next channel	
Channel-	Selects the previous channel	
Menu	Opens the device's menu	
ОК	Confirms a selection or enters a sub-menu	
Exit	Exits the current menu or cancels an action	

Additional Functions

In addition to the basic functions, the Ener001 replacement remote control also provides additional features:

Button	Function
Subtitle	Enables or disables subtitles
Audio	Changes the audio language or audio settings
Guide / EPG	Opens the electronic program guide
Text / Goto	Displays teletext or jumps to a specific location
Home	Brings you back to the home screen
Recall	Returns to the previously viewed channel or input
Pause / Step / Freeze	Pauses playback or steps through frames (if supported)
Stop / Hold	Stops playback or holds a freeze frame

FAQ

How do I replace the batteries in the Ener001 replacement remote control?

To replace the batteries, follow these steps:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the battery cover off and remove the old batteries.
- 3. Insert new batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
- 4. Slide the battery cover back into place.

Can I use the Ener001 replacement remote control with multiple devices?

The Ener001 replacement remote control is designed to work with a specific device. It may not be compatible with other devices.
