SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not attempt to charge nonrechargeable batteries.
- Do not leave rechargeable batteries in the product while charging.
- Rechargeable batteries must only be charged under the supervision of an adult.
- Insert the batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short circuit the battery terminals.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Take out old batteries. Old batteries can damage the clock.
- Only use batteries of the recommended type.
- The battery should be replaced every year, even if the clock is still showing the correct time.
- Take out the battery if the clock is not going to be used for some time.

Use

1. Open the battery cover on the back of the clock.
2. Insert an AA battery (MN1500, LR6 or equivalent) in the battery compartment on the back of the clock. Battery sold separately. Check the polarity of the battery.
3. Replace the battery cover.
4. Turn the dial on the back to set the time anticlockwise to set the correct time.
5. Turn the dial on the back to set the alarm anticlockwise until the alarm hand points to the set time.
6. Activate the alarm function by pushing up the ON/OFF switch. Note that this is a twelve-hour clock, which means that the alarm goes off twice a day if it is now switched off.
7. Switch off the alarm by pushing down the ON/OFF switch.
