

#### Introduction and operation of the main page features



#### 1. Home key

Tap this key to return to the main interface;

#### 2. Volume key

Tap the volume key to display the current volume information; You can adjust the volume I switch mute \ display the current volume status.

#### 3. Radio mode icon

Tap the radio mode icon to enter the radio operation interface.

#### 4. Bluetooth mode icon

Tap the Bluetooth mode icon to enter the Bluetooth operation interface.

#### 5. Backlight mode icon

Tap the backlight mode icon to switch between day and night or turn off the backlight mode.

#### 6. Displays the device connection status

Displays the connection status of Bluetooth or USB. When Bluetooth or USB is connected, the corresponding icon will be highlighted on the screen, otherwise, it will not be displayed.

#### 7. USB mode icon

Tap the USB mode icon to enter the USB operation interface.

#### 8. Time display

Displays the current system time; Tap it to switch the clock format to digital format display.

#### 9. Phone link mode icon

Tap the mode icon of the Phone link to enter the operation interface of the Phone link;

#### 10. SD card mode icon

Tap the SD card mode icon to enter the SD card operation interface;

#### 11. Setting mode icon

Tap the setting mode icon to enter the setting mode for operation;

#### 12. AUX mode icon

Tap the AUX mode icon to enter the AUX operation interface;

## 13. FCAM mode icon

Tap the FCAM mode icon to enter the FCAM operation interface;

#### Introduction to radio features and operation



- 1. Tap this key to browse the stored station information; long-tap this key for one second to search the station from the lowest to the highest frequency, and save the searched information to the search list, and the list will be refreshed and replaced;
- 2. Tap this key to cycle through FM >AM > FM modes;
- 3. Tap this key to switch to stereo/mono;
- 4. Tap this key to toggle remote/near distance;
- 5. Tap this key. The frequencies can be moved backward, long-touch for one second to search backward, and automatically stop when a valid station is found.
- 6. Tap this key. The frequencies can be moved forward, long-touch for one second to search forward, and automatically stop when a valid station is found.
- 7. Radio Storage Area. 18 stations can be stored on FM and 12 on AM; (AM function is optional)

#### **Introduction of Bluetooth Function:**

The system is compatible with Bluetooth V4.2+BR+EDR+BLE and supports A2DP1AVCTP 1AVDTP 1AVRCP 1 HFP 1SPP1ATT1GAP 1 GATT 1 RFCOMM 1SDP1L2CAP;





## Function introduction and operation of Phone link

**Note:** In order to use the cell phone connection function, you need to select the connection method on the vehicle side first.

Introduction to Phone link's functions: When using an Android phone for wired phone interconnection, the phone needs to turn on "USB Debugging" in "Developer Options"; when using an Android phone for wireless phone interconnection, you need to turn on the phone's "Wireless Casting" function to search for the device, and then click on the name of the device when you find it to connect wirelessly; When using iPhone for wireless phone interconnection, the phone should first connect to the WIFI of the car side, that is, open the WIFI function of the phone side to connect to the WIFI of the car side, and then click on the screen image of the phone side to search for the device, search for the target device and click on the name to achieve wireless connection;



- 1. Tap this key to enter the interface of the Android device wired phone interconnection function;
- 2. Tap this key to enter the interface of wired mobile interconnection for Apple devices;
- 3. Tap this key to enter the wired CAR PLAY interface;
- 4. Tap this key to enter the Android auto interface;

#### Common problems when using the cell phone interconnect function:

- 1. When using the wired phone interconnect back control function, you need to connect Bluetooth to use;
- 2. Some Android phones need to be touched in Mobile>Application Management > Auto link > Open "Force full-screen display";

- 1. Tap this key to enter the function setting interface, which can be slid up and down by touching it;
- 2. Tap this key to enter the audio setting interface;
- 3. Tap this key to enter the display settings interface;
- 4. Tap this key to enter the time setting interface;
- 5. Tap this key to enter the wallpaper setting interface;
- 6. Tap this key to enter the direction control setting interface;

- 1. Press and hold the steering wheel key, then click on the key icon on the steering wheel interface, the icon will change color;
- 2. After pressing all keys, tap , and learning is complete.




