



## Create a new project

In the MakeCode editor, press Tab to reach + New Project, then press Enter.




Type a name for your project, then press Enter.




### Turn on blocks keyboard controls

Press Tab, then press Enter.



#### Open or close keyboard controls help

Hold Ctrl and press



Tip: If you have space on your screen then keep the help open


#### **Workspace: General controls**

In the workspace, use general controls as needed


Action	Shortcut
Cut	Ctrl + X
Сору	Ctrl + C

Paste	Ctrl + V
Undo	Ctrl + Z
Redo	Ctrl + Y
Open context menu (right-click menu)	Ctrl + Enter
Duplicate	D
Next stack of blocks	N
Previous stack of blocks	В

## Navigate to an area: Option 1




Make Code Keyboard Controls Navigate to an area: Option 1




# Navigate to an area: Option 2

Hold Ctrl + B, press Tab to move through the numbers, and then press Enter to confirm.




## Workspace: Select the workspace

Press the W key.



Workspace: Format (tidy up) blocks


Press the F key.



## Access parts of a block


#### Workspace: Access parts of a block

Use the arrow keys to access different parts of a block.




Workspace: Move a block

Press M, then use the arrow keys to move a block. Press Enter to confirm.




#### Workspace: Move a block anywhere

- Press M, then hold Ctrl and use the arrow keys.
- Press Enter to confirm.




Workspace: Disconnect a block

Press X to disconnect a block




## Workspace: Delete a block

Press Delete or BackSpace to remove a block




Workspace: Edit or confirm

Press Enter or Space to confirm an action




## Workspace: Block navigation

Use arrow keys to navigate blocks



**Toolbox: Access the toolbox** 


Press T or hold Ctrl + B then press 3



### **Toolbox: Navigation**


Use arrow keys to navigate categories and blocks






Toolbox: Select or confirm a block


Press Enter or Space to select a block






#### **Toolbox: Search**

- In the toolbox (T), start typing the name of a block.
- Press Enter to move to results.
- Press down arrows to select a block. Press Enter to confirm.




#### Specific blocks: Show LEDs block

- Use right arrow key then Enter to access LED editor.
- Use arrows to navigate LEDs.
- Press Enter to turn LED on and off.
- Press Esc to exit.



#### Specific blocks: Play melody

- Use right arrow to move to the melody. Press Enter to open melody.
- Press Tab to edit melody. Use arrows to select a note.
- Press Enter to confirm note.
- When finished, Tab to Done and press Enter.

Use the arrow keys to navigate through different parts of a block.
