Product Specifications

- Operating Modes: Local Presentation, Web Conference, Digital Signage
- Main Menu Features: Layout selection, Source selection, Camera controls, Volume adjustment
- Audio Channels: Program Audio, Mic Volume
- Camera Control Options: Zoom, Pan, Tilt, Preset positions

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How can I mute all student microphones?

A: You can press "Mute All Students" in the Main Menu to mute all student microphones simultaneously.

Q: How do I adjust the audio volume for room microphones?

A: Use the Volume Controls to set the Mic Volume channel by dragging the slider or touching the desired level on the bar.

Turning the System On

• Step 1: Open Mode Selection Menu

Touch anywhere on welcome screen

• Step 2: Select Operating Mode Start a Local Presentation


Press "Present to Class"

Run a Web Conference

Press "Present to Web"

Show the Digital Signage

Press "Digital Signage"




Using the Main Menu

Choose a Screen Layout

Press any of the five screen layouts shown on the left side of the screen

Select a Video Source



* Selecting "Instructor Camera" or "Student Camera" will open the Camera Controls Menu automatically

Display Selected Source

Press a view window in the current screen layout to show the selected source in that window

• Share Source in Video Conference


Press "Video Conference"

Send Source to Conference Room

Press "Conference Room"

• Display Source on Student Pods

Press "Pods" *



* Press "End Send to Pods" to stop sharing selected source (button is only visible when sharing a source to the student pods)

• Turn Main Display On or Off

Press "Turn Display On/Off"

• Change Operating Mode

Press "Change Mode," refer to Page 7

· Adjust Audio Volume


Press "Volume," refer to Pages 5-6

Control the Cameras

Press "Camera Controls," refer to Page 8

• Mute Student Microphones

Press "Mute All Students," or press the microphone symbol on any pod to mute that pod's microphone



Volume Controls

• Program Audio Channel


Program refers to the volume of the currently selected source

• Mic Volume Channel

Mic Volume refers to room microphones

• Adjust Audio Volume

- A: Press the "+" and "-" buttons to increase or decrease volume
 OR
- B: Drag the slider to set the audio volume OR
- C: Touch desired level on volume bar



• Mute an Audio Channel

Press "Mute" next to the desired channel (press again to un-mute)

• Mute all Room Microphones

Press "Web Conf. Privacy"

• Mute Instructor Microphone

Press "Instructor Mute"

• Mute Ceiling Microphones

Press "Ceiling Mute"

• Mute all Student Microphones

Press "Mute Students"



Changing Operating Mode

• Step 1: Open Change Mode Menu

Press "Change Mode" on right side of screen

• Step 2: Choose Option


Start a Local Presentation

Press "Present to Class"

• Run a Web Conference

Press "Present to Web"





• Step 1: Select Camera to Control

Press name of desired camera

• Step 2: Choose Operation

Zoom Camera In or Out

Press "+" to zoom in, or "-" to zoom out

• Pan or Tilt Camera


Press arrow keys on circular keypad

• Move Camera to Preset Position

Press desired preset number

• Send Camera to Display(s)

Press desired destination from the menu on the right side of the screen

• Step 1: Open Help Menu

Press Question Mark button in bottom left corner of screen


• Step 2: Choose Help Option

• Step 1: Open System Off Menu

Press Power button in bottom left corner of screen

• Step 2: Choose Option


Leave Digital Signage Playing on Video Wall

Select "Video Wall"

- Leave Digital Signage Playing on Student Pod Displays Select "Pods"
- Turn System Off

Press "Turn System Off"
