**Cleaning machine** In these operating instructions, the dishwasher or the washer-disin- fector is referred to as "the machine".

**Load items** The term "load items" is used wherever the items to be processed are not defined in any

further detail.

**Wash water** The term "wash water" is used for the mixture of water and process chemicals.

The APFD 203 insert can be used to reprocess machine-reprocess- able carrier frames for compressed air units in a Miele dishwasher or a machine. Follow the operating instructions for your dishwasher or the machine as well as the instructions issued by the manufacturer of the carrier frames for compressed air units.

The APFD 203 insert can be used together with the A 151 lower bas- ket.



- Any seals on the load items should be protected against prolonged contact with wash water. Therefore, always
  close unused connections with protective caps or blind


# Areas of application

#### Preparing the load

- · Pull the lower basket out of the wash cabinet onto the machine
- · Place the insert into the lower
- The rear panel of the insert is facing the rear panel of the wash cab- inet.
- Check whether the carrier frame requires manual pre-cleaning, g. to remove soot.

Carry straps that point upwards can get caught in the machine spray arm and affect the cleaning result or can tear off the spray arm or damage the machine when the insert is removed.

If required, carry this pre-cleaning out in line with the manufacturer's

- Lean the carrier frame diagonally against the support grid in the rear part of the


