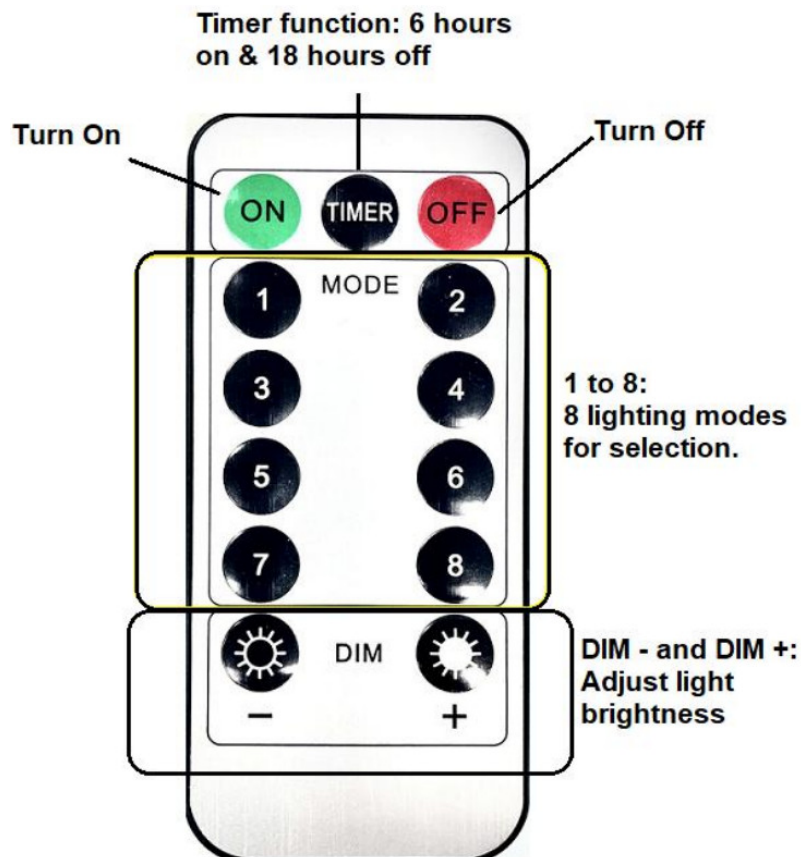
PARTS LIST

String Lights powered with 3*AA batteries (Batteries not included)
Remote Control (CR2025 battery included)
1pc of IM

HOW TO USE

1. Slide off the battery case cover;
2. Insert 3*AA batteries into the battery case in correct polarity;

3. Slide on the battery case cover;
4. Remove the clear pull tag of the remote control and press ON to turn on the lights. (the remote control should point to the battery case (with receiver built-in)).
5. Then you can use the remote control to select the mode you prefer. For detailed remote function, please see image below.



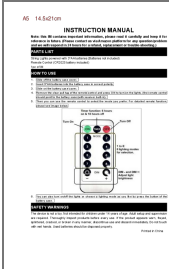
6. You can also turn on/off the lights or choose a lighting mode as you like by press the button of the battery case.
