Power On

The power button is used to start the device from a shutdown state. After connecting to an adapter or charging a lithium battery, press the power button to start the device. If you do not use the device for a long time, please shut it down.

When encountering problems, you can start the BIOS. When the logo is displayed during startup, press ESC to enter the BIOS settings utility.

Troubleshooting

This device is sturdy and durable, and rarely encounters problems when used outdoors. However, you may encounter some simple setup or operation issues that can be solved on the spot, or you may also encounter peripheral device issues that can be resolved by replacing the device. The information in this section can help you distinguish and solve certain direct problems and identify the fault problems that need to be repaired.

Define the Problem

If there is a problem with this device, through the following steps before proceeding with complex troubleshooting:

- 1. Turn off the device.
- 2. Ensure that the AC adapter is plugged into the local device and connected to an available AC power source.
- 3. Ensure that the SD cards in all available card slots are installed correctly. You can also remove the SD card from the slot to eliminate it from the possible cause of the malfunction.
- 4. Ensure that all devices connected to external connectors are properly inserted, and you can also disconnect such devices to eliminate any possible causes of malfunctions.
- 5. Turn on this device, please make sure it has been turned off for at least 10 seconds before turning it on.
- 6. Execute the startup sequence.
- 7. If the problem still cannot be resolved, please contact your customer service representative.
