Features:

- 1. The keyboard and mouse share a USB receiver and both the keyboard and mouse have their own receiver storage compartment to prevent loss
- 2. 2.4G connection, 10 meters stable transmission distance
- 3. The bottom bracket design of the keyboard can adjust the angle of the keyboard for easy use
- 4. Low power consumption, automatically enters power-saving mode when not in use
- 5. Mute mouse buttons

Instructions:

Open the battery cover at the bottom of the keyboard, take out the receiver, insert the receiver into the USB port of the computer, put a AA battery (AA battery) into the battery slot, cover the keyboard battery cover, and then open the battery cover of the mouse to put a battery Insert AA batteries (AA batteries) into the battery slot and then cover the mouse battery cover to use.

Precautions:

- 1. Do not expose the battery to humidity and high temperature, and avoid contact with conductive materials or liquids
- 2. Do not short circuit
- 3. Do not disassemble or attempt to repair this product by yourself.
- 4. If the product does not operate normally, please contact the after-sales department in time to obtain relevant services or maintenance storage methods:
