Touch Operation

Connect with Bluetooth device



- Open the Bluetooth settings option of the Bluetooth device to be paired, enter the options and find the Bluetooth pairing name to pair.

Indicator Light Description

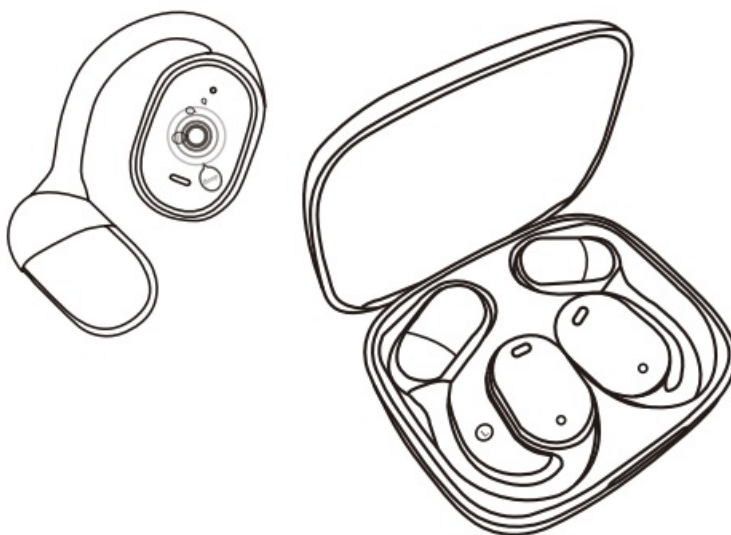


- When the headset is turned on: the white light and the ice blue light flash alternately

- When the headset is turned off: the white light flashes 3 times quickly and then goes out
- Pairing status: white light and ice blue light flash alternately
- Connection successful: no light



- Headphone charging: The charging case indicator light is always white, and the white indicator light for the headphones is always on. After the earphones are fully charged, they turn off, and the charging case indicator light also goes off.
- Charging of the charging case: The charged, the red indicator light on the charging case remains on.



Power On

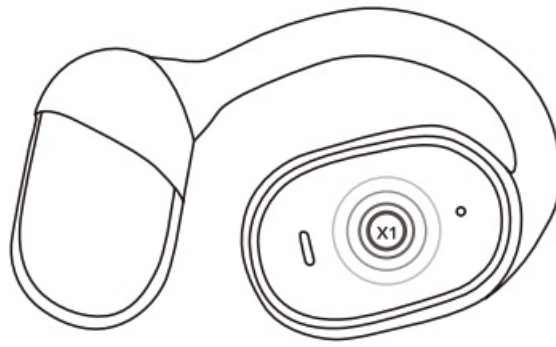
Automatic power on: The earphones are in the charging case, open the charging case cover, and the Earphones will be powered on, with the prompt sound of “Du”. Manual power-on: Long press for 3 seconds, the Earphone will be powered on, with the prompt sound of “Du”.

Power Off

Auto power off: Put the Earphones in the charging case, and close the charging case cover, the Earphones will be powered off, with the prompt sound of “Du”. Manual power off: Long press for 5 seconds, the Earphone will be powered off, with the prompt sound of “Du”.

Note: After powering on, if it is not paired with a Bluetooth device for 3 minutes, it will automatically shut down; If it is not connected to a Bluetooth device after 3 minutes, it will automatically power off after 3 minutes, with the prompt sound et “on” ”

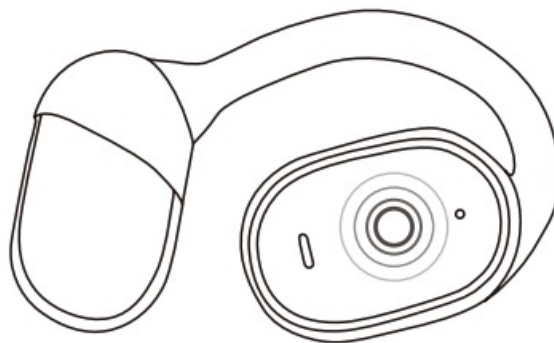

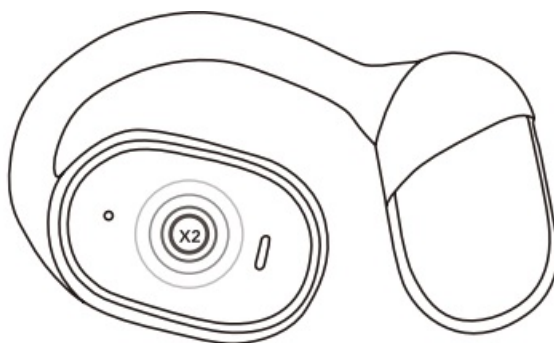

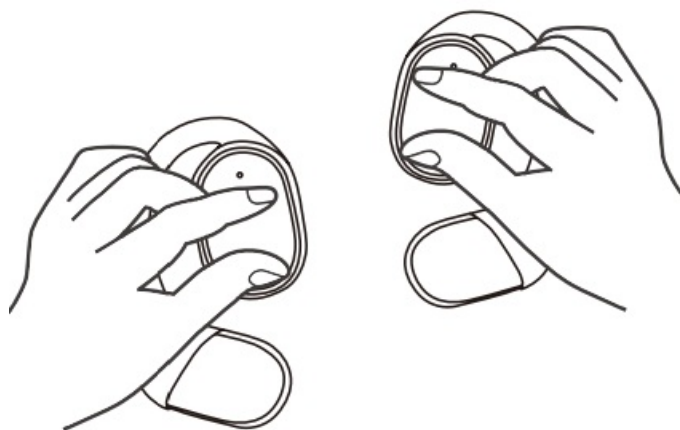

Clear Bluetooth pairing history

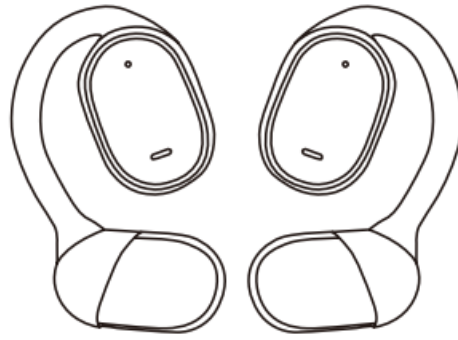
When both ears cannot be paired, you need to clear all connected devices and click the left and right earphones 5 times at the same time.



Wireless pairing mode

1. When there is no pairing record for the left and right earphones, thereon. After successful pairing, there Will be to beep aro
2. When the left and right earphones have pairing records, they will automatically connect back when they are turned on, and the prompt will sound “beep”

Switch between game mode and music mode (Binaural operation)



Game mode



Press and hold the multi-function button on the right ear for 2 seconds

Music mode



Press and hold again for 2 seconds

- **Note 1:** When using one earphone, you cannot switch between game mode and music mode.
- **Note 2:** The factory setting defaults to music mode

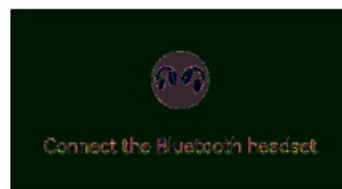
Bluetooth status

White status: The charging compartment is not connected to the headphones

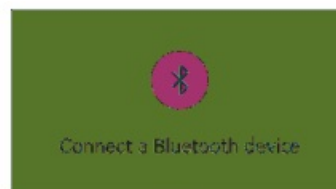
Green status: The charging compartment is connected to the earphones, but the earphones are not connected to the phone

Blue status: The charging compartment is connected to the headphones, and the headphones are connected to the phone.

- No. 1: This interface represents the use of this function, which requires the charging compartment to be connected to the headphones.
- No. 2: This interface represents the use of this feature, which requires headphones to be connected to Bluetooth devices on the phone or computer.

Battery status

- Blue: fully charged
- Red: Low battery
- White: Normal battery level, not charging

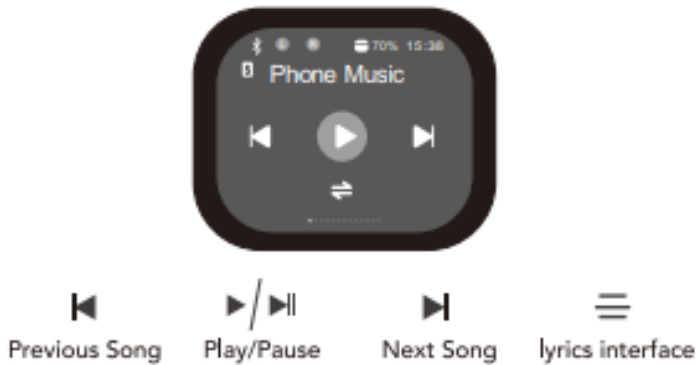

Unlock: Slide to the right to unlock the screen



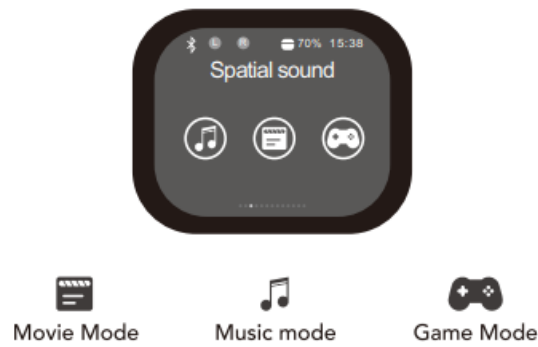

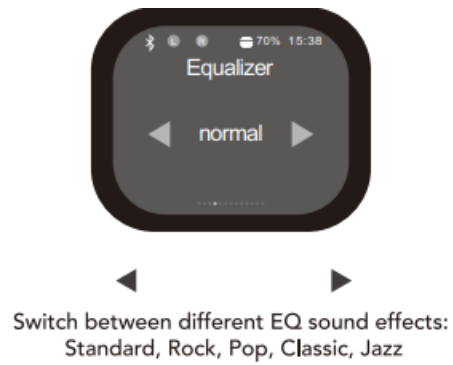

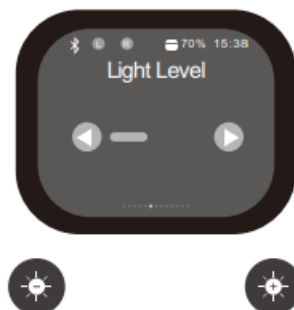

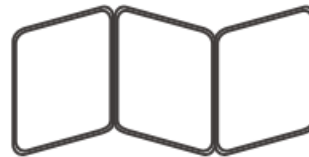


Click the button to turn on the flashlight, the entire screen turns white and the brightness of the screen increases

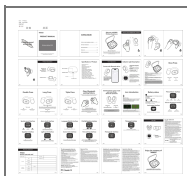
