2. Click on the top right download button.
3. Select the system (Mac OS) you need to download the driver for.
4. Click on the download button and then click "Accept".
5. Open the downloaded file.
6. Follow the prompts to complete the installation.
7. MacBook users need to allow the screen recording settings. This operation is only for extending the screen.  
Follow the specific instructions provided.

**Note:** The steps mentioned above are specific to Mac OS. For other systems, such as Windows, Android,

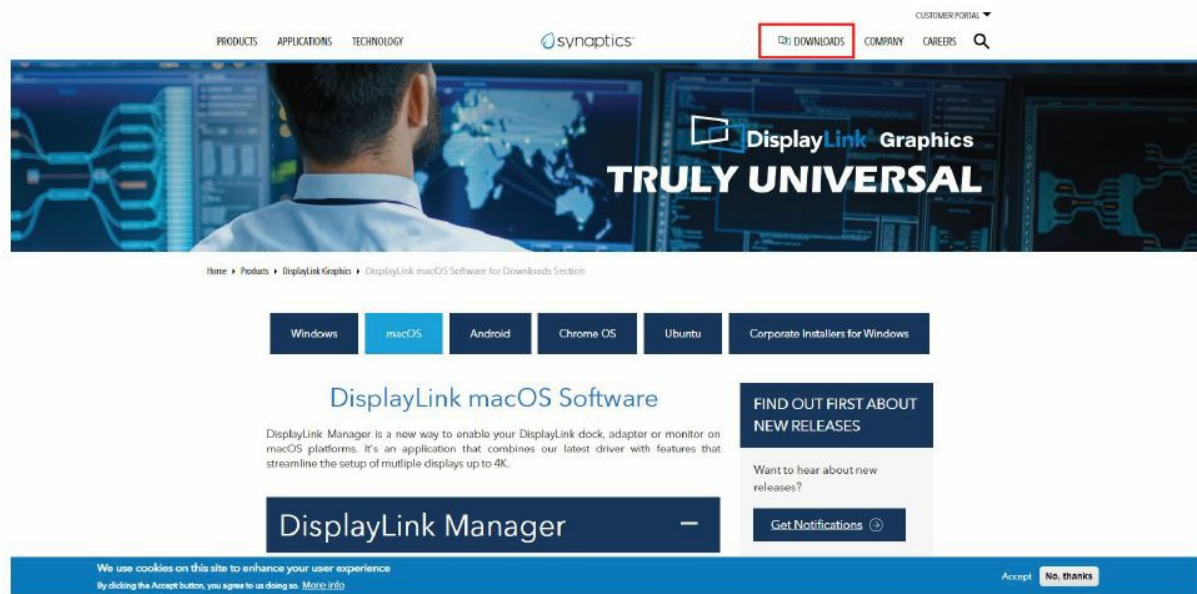

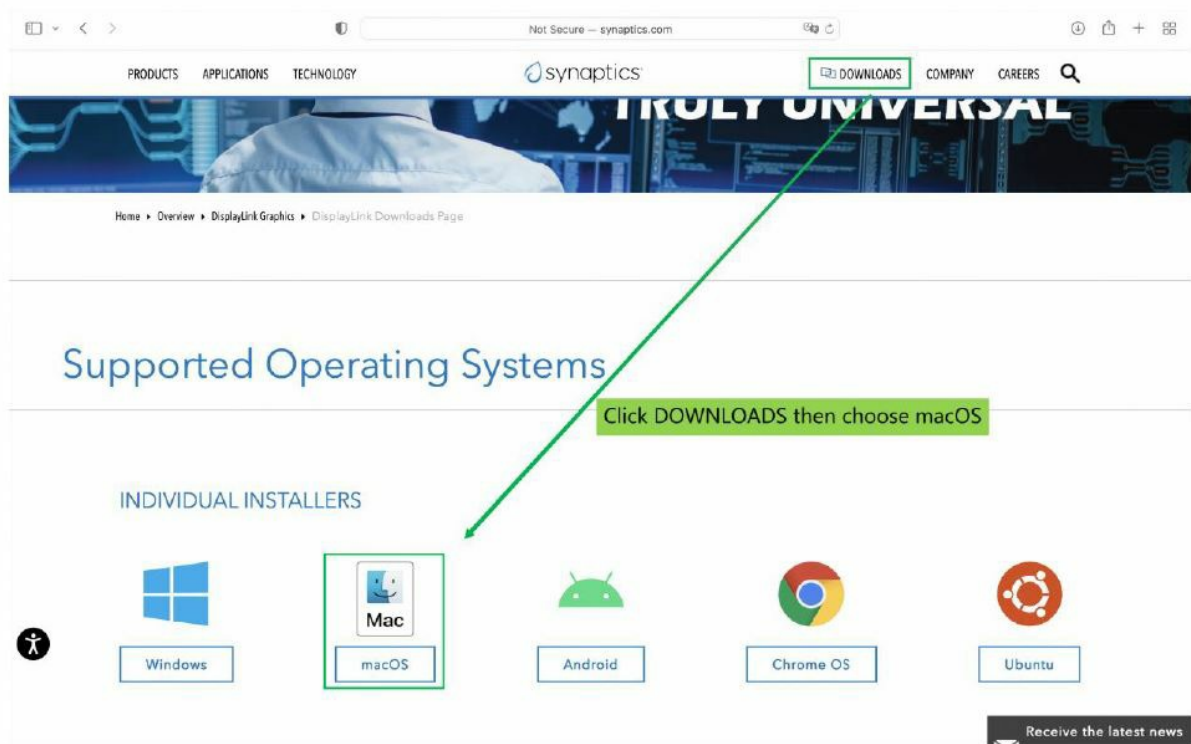
## Detailed Steps

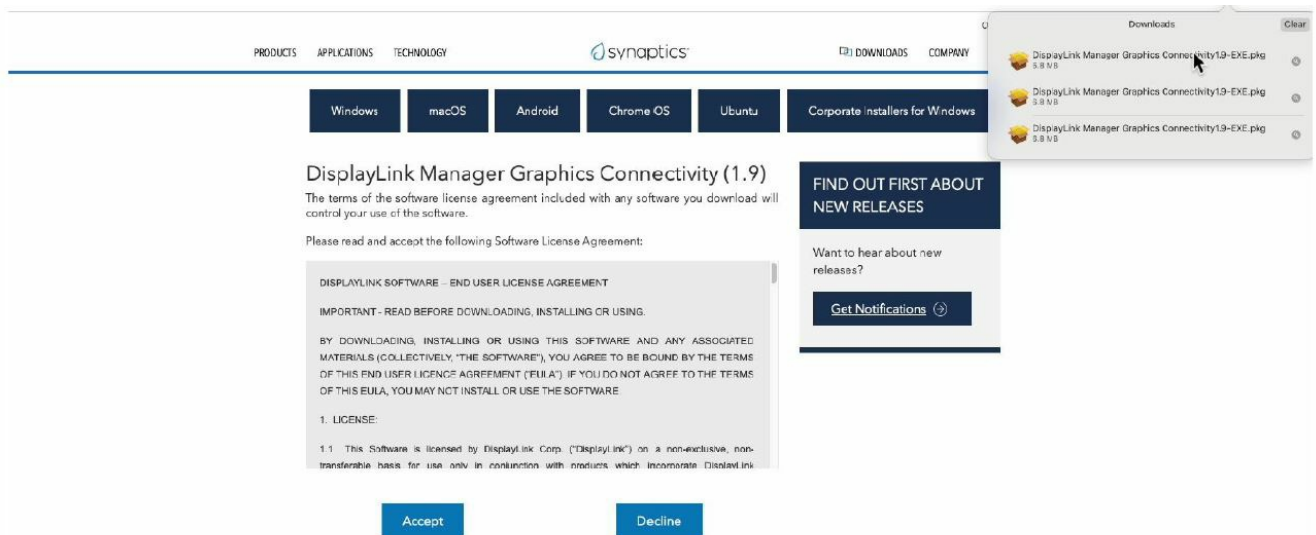

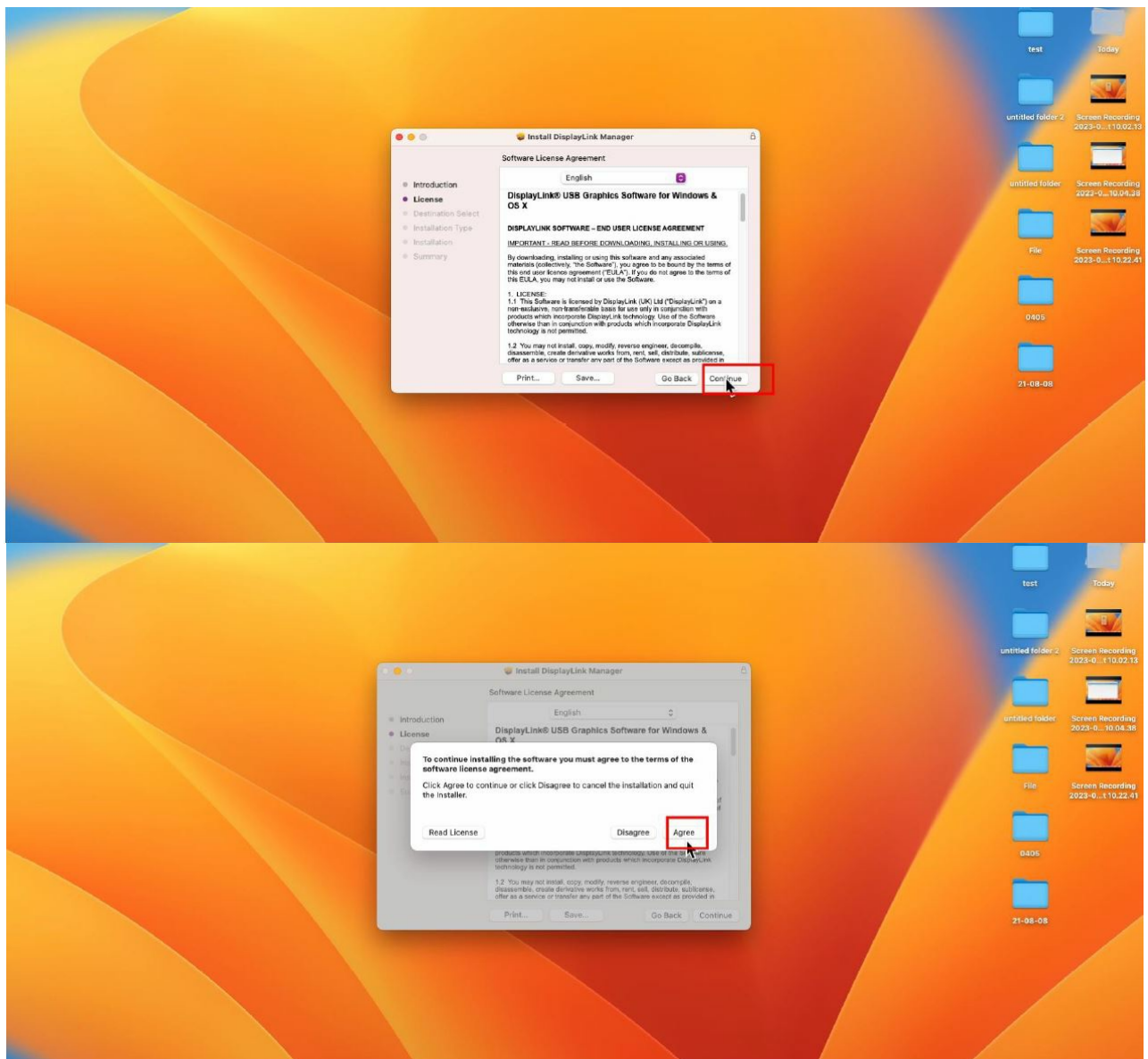

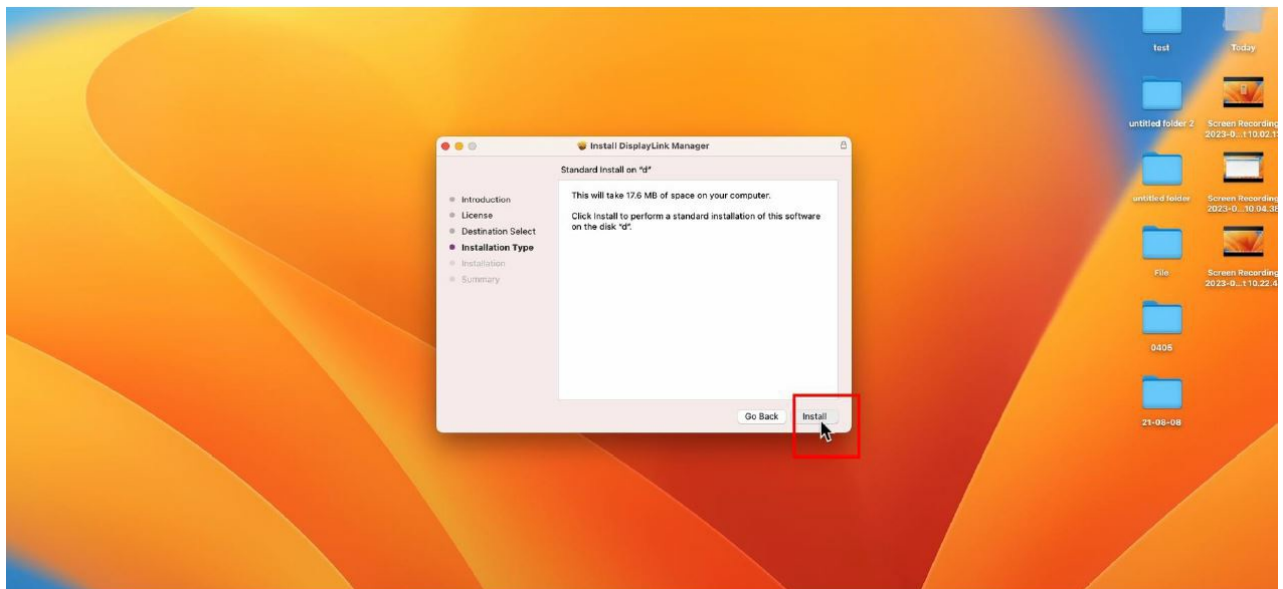
