## **Product Usage Instructions**

## **Playing and Repeating Tracks**

1. To play a track, press the stop() button.

- 2. To enter programming mode, press the PROG/FM button.
- 3. To repeat a specific part of a track:
  - When the player reaches that part, press the A-B button once. The display will show "A ON".
  - When it reaches the end of that part, press the A-B button again. The display will show "A-B ON".
  - · The player will now only repeat that specific part.
  - To stop repeating that part, press the A-B button again. The display will show "A-B OFF". The player will
    resume playing in order.

#### **Connecting to a Bluetooth Device**

- 1. Turn on your Bluetooth headphone/speaker and ensure that Bluetooth is turned on.
- 2. Select the "BT Search" option.
- 3. Press the PLAY button to start searching for nearby Bluetooth devices.
- 4. Press the PLAY button to select the name of your device that needs to be connected to.
- 5. After successfully pairing, press the BLUETOOTH button to return to the play interface.

#### **Using the FM Transmitter**

- 1. When playing CDs, press the play/pause() button first, then press the PROG/FM button.
- The FM transmitter frequency will appear on the display. Press the PROG/FM button again to change the frequency.
- 3. Choose one of the available frequencies: 78.1, 79.3, 87.5, 88.5, 93.6, 103, 107.1, or OFF.
- 4. Turn on the car radio device and adjust the frequency to match the one chosen on the CD player.
- 5. You can now listen to the CD through the car radio device.

#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

Please read this manual carefully before using this player and keep it for later reference.

#### Warning:

#### The player

To reduce the risk of fire or avoid damage to the human body, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Never touch the lens of the device. Always keep the disc compartment closed to prevent dust from collecting on the lens.
- 2. If the device is unable to scan discs properly, use a standard commercially available cleaner to clean the laser optics. Other cleaning methods may damage the laser optics.
- 3. Clean the device with a clean, damp leather cloth. Do not use any cleaning agents.
- 4. If the player fails to work, please contact our after-sales staff in time, professional technical support staff will provide you with detailed answers.
- 5. The player can not be used or stored in a moist environment, please keep the player away from any liquid, steam,m, or vapor, such as raindrops, mist, etc.
- 6. Please do not place any liquid or metal gadgets onto the player, such as a pin or a cup of coffee.
- 7. Please do not expose the player to the sunlight and keep it away from the fire heater. The player can not be placed in a high-temperature environment.
- 8. All professionals with extensive electronic knowledge and maintenance experience are allowed to disassemble the player for maintenance. The replacement of spare parts must be done in strict accordance with the parameters of the Circuit design.
- 9. Please do not stick or hit the player with sharp objects.
- 10. There are light-emitting diodes in this player, staring directly with eyes should be avoided to prevent visual impairment from being caused.
- 11. Children under 12 years are not allowed to use the player individually.
- 12. When charging, ensure that the Power source and the Charging voltage are DC 5V/1A. Excessive voltage input may cause machine overload damage.

#### **Battery**

If the player you purchased contains batteries, please do not disassemble the player or charge the player with other adapters that do not meet the electrical parameters of this product to avoid Circuit failure. For your safety, please treat the built-in high-capacity polymer lithium battery by following the instructions below:

- 1. Please do not remove the battery pack.
- 2. Please do not beat or impact this piaye
- 3. Please do not make the battery short-circuit or pierce it.
- 4. Please do not place the player under high temperature which is above 140 F (60 C).
- 5. Please do not put the battery in a fire.
- 6. If the battery has been damaged, please ask a professional to replace the battery with the same specification, or contact our after-sales support for help

#### Hearing protection

#### Listen at medium volume:

Please adjust the volume to an appropriate level. If the volume is too high, it may damage your hearing or even cause permanent damage.

#### Set the volume to a low level:

Increasing the volume slowly, until a comfortable, clear sound can be heard.

#### Listen to the audio within a reasonable time frame:

Long time listening, even at a reasonable volume may cause damage to your hearing. Please use the product

properly and get a rest when necessary.





#### How to insert a disC

- Push the OPEN button to the right to open the door. Insert your index finger into the center hole of the disc and take the edge of the disc with your thumb.
- Keep the side with words upward while inserting the disc into the CD player, press the disc gently to make it steady, and make sure the disc has been in place.
- Close the disc door gently and completely, otherwise, the player will not read the disc.
- Keep pressing for 2 seconds to switch to the TF card

(Note: The player is only compatible with CD, CDR, MP3, and HDCD formats.)




### Insert an earphone

Only earphone with a 3.5mm plug is compatible with this player.

Note: Only "  $\Omega^{1}$  supports headset control

#### How to turn on the player

The power switch is located on the side. Please toggle it to the ON position to play normally. When a disc is played to the end or there is no disc, the player will enter a standby mode after 20 seconds. Please press the PLAY button again to restart the player.




## How to turn off the player

There are two ways to turn off the player:


- 1. Please toggle the power switch to OFF position if the player will no longer be used for a long time;
- 2. The player will enter a standby mode by pressing the SIOP button twice in succession, but at this time, the power of the player is not completely disconnected.

Note: Please turn the power switch to the OFF position if the player will no longer be used for a long time.



## How to charge for the player

- How to choose a charger: This product is only equipped with one charging cable. You can choose any charger that supports USB2.0 protocol or a standard USB charger of a cellphone running in Android or iOS system to charge the player.
- Charging time: It will take around 4 hours to fully charge the player according to the standard USB2.0 protocol. When the battery is being charged, the LED indicator is red. Once the player is fully charged, the LED indicator will turn green.




#### How to set up the circle mode

- Each time the MODE button is pressed, the order of the tracks played will be as follows: Repeat (1),
- Repeat all (ALL), random play (RAND), and preview play (INTRO) (only 10 seconds per track will be played in this mode).




## How to program the play

- Press the stop button first and press the PROG/FM button to enter the programming mode when the play stops, press the PREVIOUS or NEXT button to select the track you want to program, and press PROG again to confirm the programming.
- Up to 30 tracks can be programmed in this mode. After that, press the PLAY button to enter the programming play mode. Press the STOP button directly to enter the stop mode to cancel or reprogram.



#### How to set sound

**How to adjust volume:** The volume knob is located on the side of the player. Rotate it to the left or right to decrease or increase the volume. Please listen to music at an appropriate volume to protect your ears.




**AB**: If you just want to repeat the specific part of a track, when the player is playing that part, please press the A-B button one time, the display show "A ON", then when it plays to the end of that part, press the A-B button once again, the display shows "Ab ON". After that, the player will only repeat that specific part.

**NOTE**: If you want to stop repeating that part, just press the A-B button once again, the display will show "Ab OFF", and it will play in order.

#### How to adjust the volume

The volume knob is located on the side of the player. Rotate it to the left or right to decrease or increase the volume. Please listen to music at an appropriate volume to protect your ears.



#### How to set EQ effect

Press the EQ button to change the different sound effects. There are a total of 5 sound effects: BBS, POP, JAZZ, ROCK, and CLASSIC.




#### How to connect Bluetooth devices

- 1. Turn on your Bluetooth headphone/speaker and make sure that the Bluetooth is turned on.
- 2. Press the Bluetooth button on the player. If the Bluetooth is off, you need to press the play button to turn on the Bluetooth.



- 3. Select the" BT Search option, then press the PLAY button, and the CD player will start searching nearby Bluetooth devices.
- 4. Press the PLAY button to select the name of your device that needs to connect to.
- 5. After being paired successfully. press the BLUETOOTH butón to return to the play interface.



#### **OTHER FEATURES**


#### The time setting of the screen sleep

The screen will be turned off after 10 seconds of inactivity. The screen will be turned on when any button IS pressed.

#### **Key lock**

After playback mode and sound effects have been set up, you can toggle the power switch to the HOLD position

to prevent the environment, for example, naughty children or crowded occasions from affecting the setting of the player.



#### **Connect to AUX devices**

To use this player on different occasions, an extra AUX cable has been supplied to connect this player to any device with an AUX interface conveniently, such as home theater, music center, Bluetooth speakers, vehicles, headphone amplifiers, and more.

#### How to use an FM transmitter

please follow the below steps to use Fan M transmitter to connect the car radio device

- 1. When playing CDs, press the play/pause ►II) button first and pressthe PROG/FM button, FM transmitter frequency Will show up on the display. Press it again, the frequency will change. Choose one frequency you prefer.
  - Six FM transmitter frequencies are optional 78.1, 79.3, 87.5, 88.5, 93.6, 103, 107.1, OF
- 2. Turn on the car radio device and adjust the frequency to the same frequency you choose on the CD player.
- 3. You can listen to the CD on the car audio device now.
