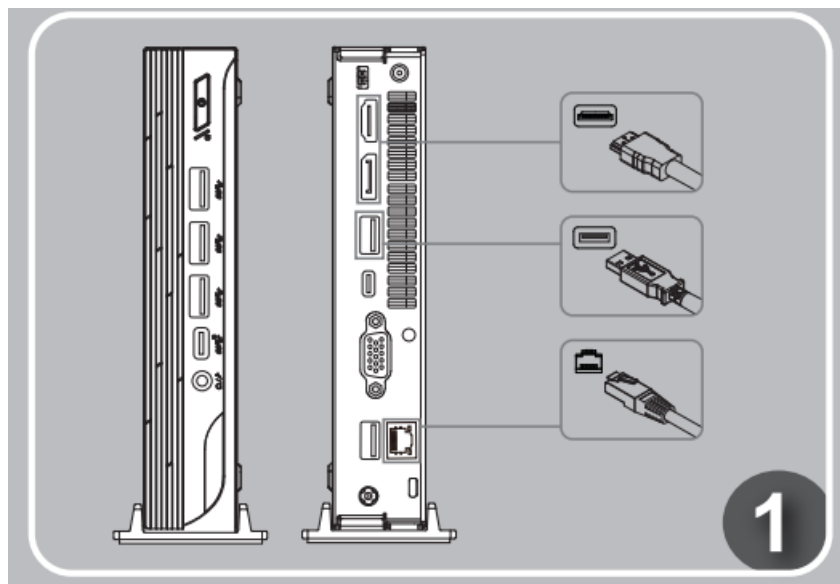

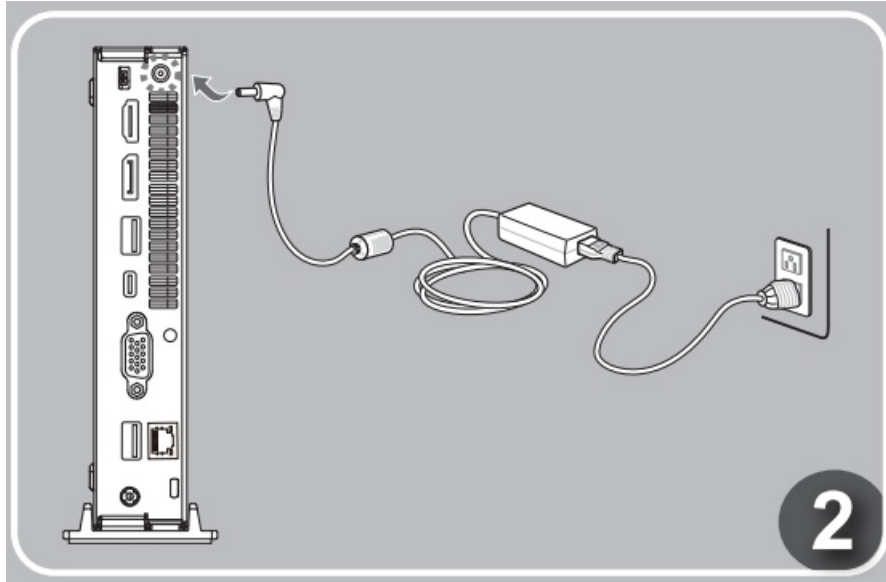

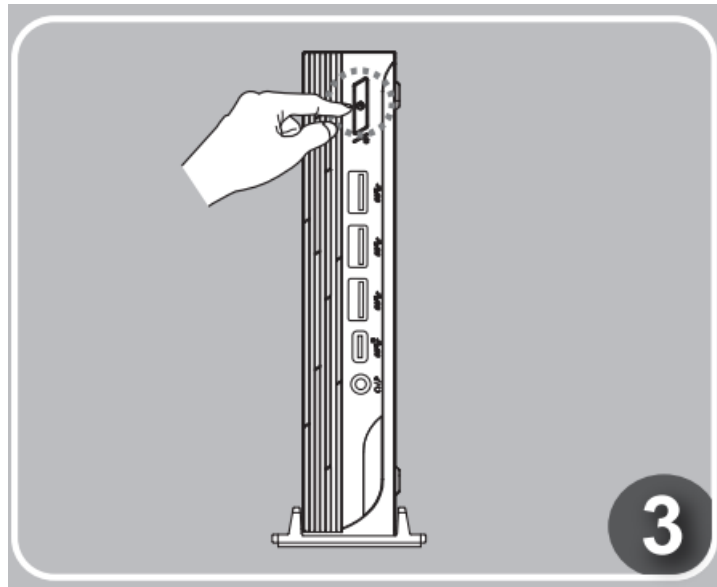
DP10 13M Intel Core i5 1340P Barebone

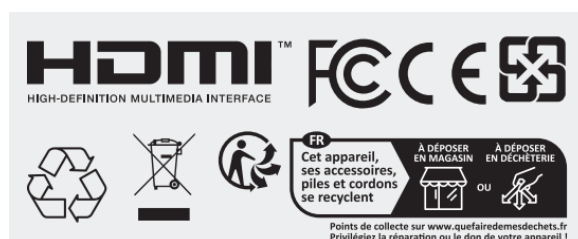
