#### **Overview**

The install tool is intended to improve the installation and commissioning efficiency of cameras, and provide solutions to common construction problems, such as IP address modification, temporary power and network supply, voltage detection, etc. The product features multiusage, lightweight and easy to carry.


In the actual deployment, the construction personnel can install and test the camera with the ILLUMIVUE TECH app that connects the box, without connecting to the PC, simplifying and mobilizing the deployment process. For some constructionsite s without electricity and network, the box can provide temporary power supply and network, so that the camera can get online to help to adjust the installation angle.

#### **■ NOTE!**

- Turn off the box to extend its battery life if you don't useit.
- The battery performance may degrade at low temperatures.

## **Appearance and Interfaces**

The appearance and interfaces may vary with device model. The figure below is only for illustration.

#### **■ NOTE!**

- Press the Reset button and hold for at least 10 seconds to restore the default Wi-Fi configuration.
- When the power switch is ON, long press to turn off the box. Press the button again to turn on the box.

# i CAUTION!

The DC12V output and PoE output cannot be used at the same time. Otherwise, the connected external devices may be powered off due toinsufficient box battery.

## **Device Management**

## 1. Start up the box

Turn on the power switch to start up the box, and then the system indicator is steady green.






2. Connect network port and DC 12V output \* The power cable supplied with the box and network cable purchased separately are required.

\* To supply power to the camera, please connect the network cable to the network port marked with PoE output.





### 3. Connect the box Wi-Fi with your phone


View the Wi-Fi SSID on the device label, and connect your phone to the box Wi-Fi.



4. **Download and install UNV-Link Pro app**Select Connect Box and follow the onscreen instructions to add cameras to the app.

#### 5. Adjust and test device

You can adjust parameters of the connected cameras, including changing camera name or password, syncing mobile phone's long tude and latitude to the camera, etc.
