Installation

To install the SQUID, follow these steps:

- 1. Make sure the mouse and keyboard are in Auto Power Sleep mode.
- 2. Insert the battery into the device.
- 3. Press any button to wake up the device.
- 4. The SQUID is now ready for use.

Battery Insertion / Removal

- 2. Locate the battery compartment on the device.
- 3. Open the battery compartment cover.
- 4. Insert or remove the battery as needed.
- 5. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

DPI Change

To change the DPI settings on the SQUID, follow these instructions:

- 1. Make sure the device is turned on.
- 2. Locate the DPI button on the device.
- 3. Press the DPI button to cycle through different DPI settings.
- 4. Release the DPI button when your desired DPI setting is reached.

- The devices are ready for use.


Note: The mouse and keyboard are equipped with Auto Power Sleep mode, which is activated after several seconds of inactivity, press any button to wake it up.




