PROJECTION OVER A WIDE AREA

The projection distance ranges from 2 to 10 metres (6.5 to 32.80 feet), with a projected area of 120 square metres at 3 metres and 200 square metres at 5 metres. Google Assistant and Alexa are also compatible with Project Galaxy. Use ALEXA to control the smart led music light. It's simple enough for even your kids to ask Alexa to activate a star-projecting projector.

Bluetooth Speaker

To ensure that you don't forget to turn off the night light projector, there is also a sleep timer that can be set to 1, 2, or 4 hours. The can project a soothing, flowing nebula or a slowly moving ocean wave while simultaneously playing music and audiobooks from a USB thumb drive or via Bluetooth from your smartphone to assist your child.

MULTI-FUNCTION

It may be used as a dimmable night light, ambient light for an ocean wave, stage party light, disco ball, and game room light. 4 single colours, 10 multicolor combinations, and 21 Fantastic Lighting Modes are included.

FAQ's

Are NELEVO projectors acceptable for youngsters to use on a daily basis?

Yes! Children that require sleep help should definitely choose the NELEVO projector.

Projectors — do they improve student response?

Since children's interests vary regularly and projectors' functionality and diversity help them stay current, kids are the perfect target market for them.

Either the colour of the galaxy night light changes automatically or not at all.

Using the colour buttons (R, G, B, and W) or mode button, you may set the remote control to swap modes every three cycles or maintain the current mode.

Which power block type and wattage should I buy? The manual is silent on this subject.

I just plugged my device into an outlet.

Does the integrated microphone for the music syncing feature function, or does it just sync with music played over the Bluetooth speaker?

A microphone is not built-in.

Does this require constant recharging or can it be recharged remotely?

No! It's not necessary for you to constantly be online.

How are the white noise and Bluetooth switched?

To switch, press the product button panel for two seconds, then immediately press the "mode" button on the remote control.

Does this product require an outlet to operate or can it be powered by a power bank using a USB connection?

On either, it operates flawlessly.

How long does the NELEVO projector take to cool down?

After being switched off, the NELEVO projector has to cool down for at least ten minutes. Before relocating your projector, give it time to completely cool off to prevent damage or overheating. Don't move it again.

How long does the NELEVO battery last the projector?

Keeping a NELEVO backup battery:

Batteries for projectors typically last 90 minutes to 12 hours. Therefore, using a backup is much preferable to letting the battery eventually run out for both you and the battery.

Is it safe for young children to use a projector?

The basic objective of a projector is to promote sound sleep in children. When taken every day at night, there are no risks. Thanks to its excellent display, it won't harm your kids' or newborns' eyes in any way.

Does a projector give a damn about the dark?

The visual quality does, however, improve with increasing darkness. For a projector to create contrast that makes an image appear bold rather than washed out, darkness is required. It will also be simpler to perform any necessary color calibration as a result.

Why is my projector not producing any light?

In case the lamp went out or the projector or display was unintentionally turned off, it is advisable to check the warning/display lights on the projector. If the system is managed by a touch panel, look for the menu on the control panel to manually turn on the projector or display. Try turning on and off the system.
