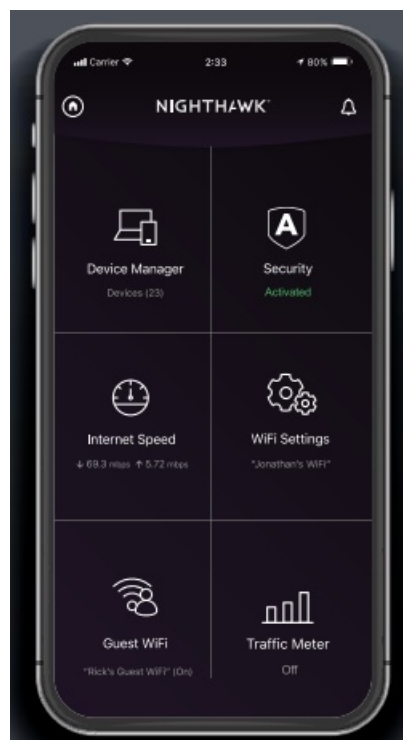
1. Download the Nighthawk app to install your mesh system on your mobile phone, download the Nighthawk app and follow the setup instructions.

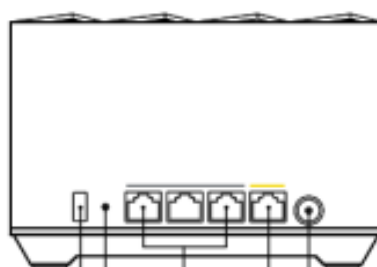

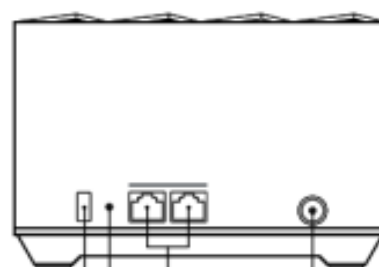
