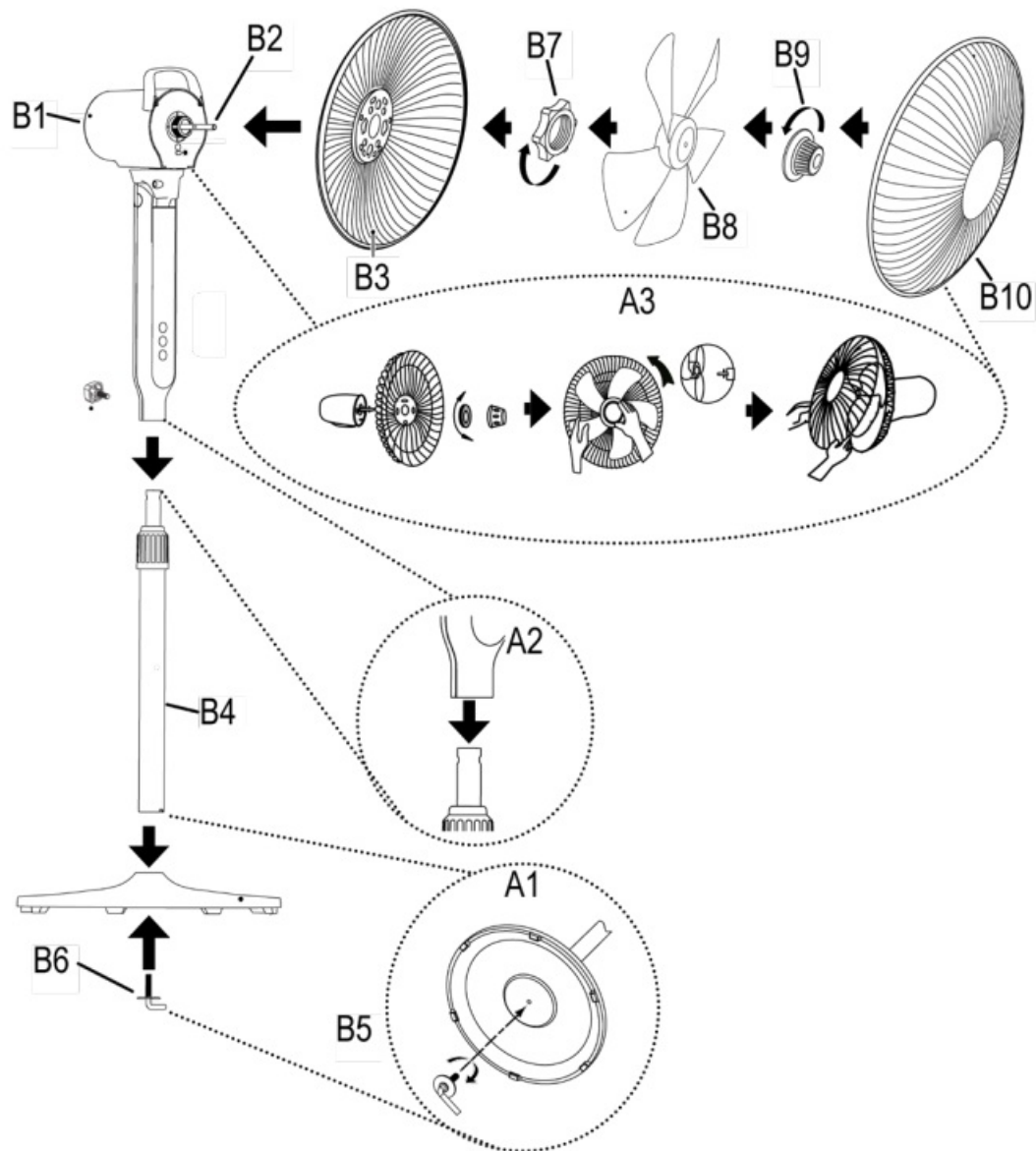

Assembly



- B1. Motor
- B2. Motor shaft
- B3. Back fan guard
- B4. Pole
- B5. Base
- B6. Bottom screw
- B7. Lock nut (back fan guard)
- B8. Fan blade
- B9. Lock nut (fan blade)
- B10. Front fan guard

A1 -> A2

Attach the base to the pole. Attach the poles together.

Fan blade (B7-> B9)

Attach the lock nuts and fan blade in order.

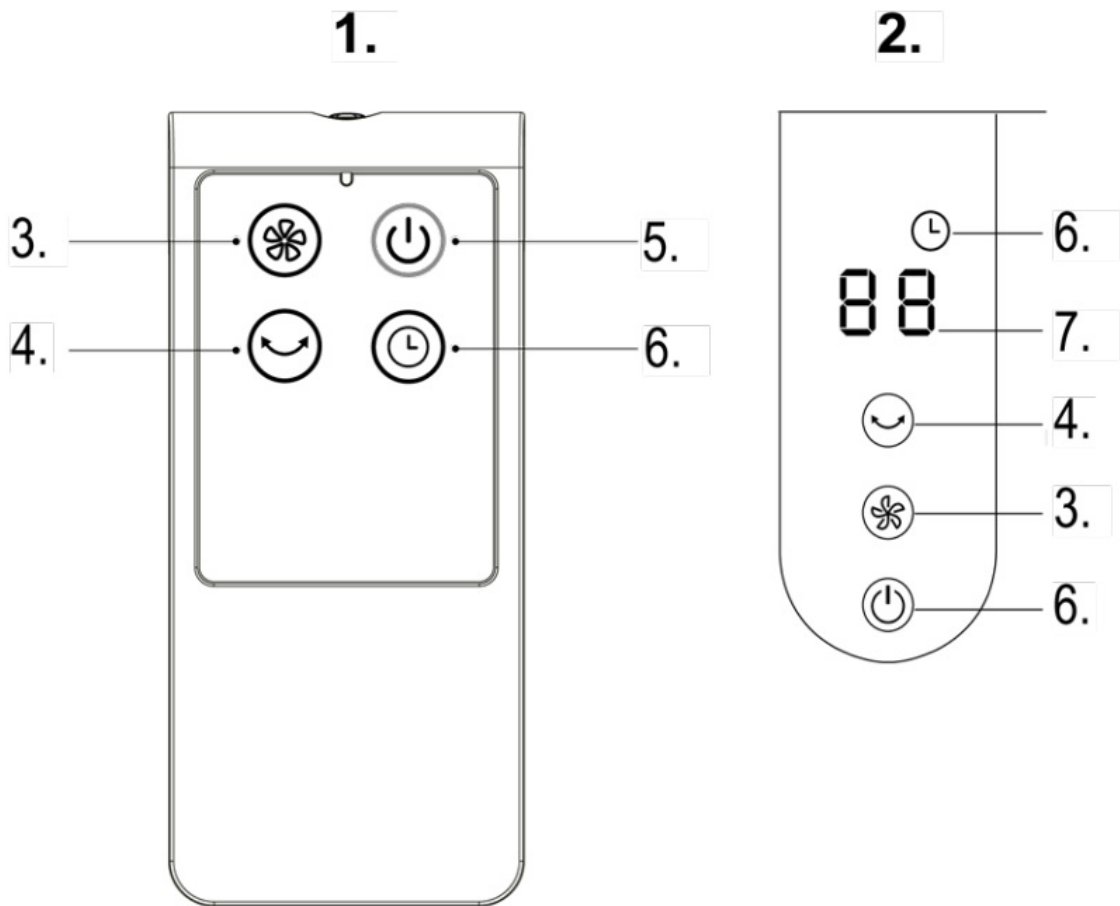
Attach the fan guards together -> It helps to press in sequence 1, 2, 3 -> Attach the screw.

Height adjustment

Turn to adjust height.

The remote control has a range of 5 meters and 30° wide angle. Batteries: 2 x AAA.



1. Remote
2. Control panel (on the fan)
3. Fan speed
4. Oscillation on/off
5. On/off
6. Timer (Button)
7. Speed and timer display

Safety instructions

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS

1. If the power cord or plug is damaged, have it replaced by qualified personnel.
2. To protect against electrical shock; do not immerse the device, cord and/or plug into water or other liquid.
3. This device can be used by children 8 years and above, people with disabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they are kept under supervision or given instructions concerning the use of the device in a safe way and that they understand the risks. Children should not play with the device. Cleaning and maintenance should not be done by children without supervision.
4. Unplug the device from the mains outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
5. Keep electrical appliances out of reach of children or debilitated persons. Do not let them use the device without supervision.
6. When the fan has been assembled, the rotor blade guard should not be removed anymore.
 - Prior to cleaning unplug the fan.

- The rotor guard should not be disassembled/opened to clean the rotor blades.
 - Wipe the fan enclosure and rotor blade guard with a slightly damp cloth.
7. Never insert fingers, pencils or any other object through the protective blade guard when fan is running.
 8. Disconnect fan when moving from one place to another.
 9. Be sure that the fan is on a stable surface when you use it, to avoid tipping it over.
 10. If the fan tips over during operation, turn the device off and unplug it from the mains immediately.
 11. Do not use the fan near the window, rain may create an electrical hazard.
 12. For indoor use only.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

Maintenance and cleaning

The fan requires little maintenance. If the fan has been broken and requires service, contact qualified personnel.

1. The fan must be disconnected from the mains before cleaning and assembly.
2. To ensure adequate air flow to the fan motor, keep the vents on the back of the fan motor free of dust. Note: Do not disassemble the fan to remove dust.
3. Wipe the exterior with a soft wet cloth and mild detergent.
4. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents to prevent scratching the surface. Do not use any of the following as a cleaner: gasoline, or thinning solvent.
5. Protect the motor housing and internal parts from water and other liquids.
6. Plastic parts should be cleaned with a soft cloth moistened with mild soap. Thoroughly remove soap film with dry cloth.
