

Product Usage Instructions

Setup:

- 1. Unbox the product carefully.
- 2. Assemble parts A, B, C, D, E, F, and G according to the provided diagram.
- 3. Connect cables P1, P2, P3, P4, P5, and P6 to their respective ports.
- 4. Place the product on a stable surface.

Operation:

- 1. Switch on the device using the power button.
- 2. Follow the on-screen instructions for initial setup.
- 3. Use buttons W1, W2, W3, W4, W5, W6, and W7 for navigation.


Maintenance:

CAUTIONS

- Placement: Place the cat tree in a safe, stable location away from fire, hazards, and windows. Make sure the location of the cat tree does not pose a threat to people and other animals.
- Stability: Make sure the cat tree remains stable during use. Check the connecting parts, support rods and bases to ensure that they are fastened and reliable. Avoid using cat trees on carpet or slippery surfaces where they can become unstable.

 Make sure all materials used are non-toxic, non-irritating, and not prone to sharp edges or protrusions to keep your cat safe.

MAINTENANCE


SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND WARNINGS:


- Pet Use Only: Please make sure the cat tree is for cats only, not for children or other animals.
- Stability: When installing and using the cat tree, please make sure it is stable and firmly placed on the -ground to prevent the cat tree from tipping over or shaking.
- Regular Inspections: Regularly inspect the structure and connecting parts of your cat tree to make sure there are no loose or damaged parts. If any problem is found, please repair or replace it in time.
- Safe Perimeter: When choosing a location for a cat tree, consider a safe perimeter around it to prevent your cat from falling or getting injured. Avoid placing cat trees on cliff edges or in areas with dangerous objects.
- Avoid High Jumps: While cat trees offer opportunities to climb and jump, make sure your cat doesn't jump off
 platforms that are too high to avoid injury. If the cat is unwilling to jump off, provide a safe way for them to get
 down.
- Supervision: When cats are using the cat tree, please maintain supervision, especially when using it for the first time or when there are new adjustments or additions to the cat tree. Make sure your cat doesn't get stuck or get stuck in an unsafe position.


READ INSTRUCTIONS: Before using the cat tree, please read and understand the complete instructions, and follow the directions and warnings provided by the manufacturer.

ASSEMBLY STEPS

- Unpack the cat climbing tree and make sure all parts are complete.
- Lay the base flat on the assembly site, making sure there is enough room for the entire cat climbing tree.
- Using a screwdriver or other tool, attach the post to the base mount.
- Note that the post may need to be screwed or otherwise secured to the base for stability.
- Mount the platform or other accessories on the posts following the design of the cat climbing tree.
- Make sure all parts are installed tightly to ensure the stability of the cat climbing the tree.
- Check all parts to make sure they are installed correctly and nothing is loose or skewed.
- Retighten the screws or adjust the connection if necessary.

CAT CLIMBING TREE USER GUIDE:

- Put the cat climbing tree in a suitable place, which can be the living room, bedroom or balcony, etc.
- Guide the cat close to the cat climbing tree and allow it to explore and use freely.
- If the cat is unfamiliar or unwilling to climb, inducers such as catnip, cat toys, or cat treats can be used to help encourage the cat to climb the tree.
- If the cat climbs the tree, praise it and give rewards to increase the cat's interest and enthusiasm for climbing the tree
- Regularly clean the cat climbing tree, especially the hair and dust on the platform and accessories, to keep it clean and hygienic.

PRECAUTIONS:

- When installing the cat climbing tree, it is important to ensure that all parts are fastened tightly to avoid accidental injury.
- When using a cat to climb a tree, please supervise the cat closely to ensure its safety.
- If your cat has abnormal behavior or discomfort when using the cat to climb trees, please stop using it in time and consult a veterinarian.
