




# **Initial Setup Configuration initiale**



First press A/B/X/Y or the D-pad to wake up the controller. In the home screen, select [Controllers] > [Change Grip/Order]. Once on the pairing screen, press and hold the sync button at the top of the controller by the charging port. On the next screen, press and hold the Sync button for at least 2 seconds and then follow the instructions. Once paired, the player indicator light will be illuminated.

# **Charging the Controller**




When the controller is low on battery, the function button's LED will blink RED every 30 seconds. Using the included micro-USB, connect the controller to the Nintendo Switch dock. While charging, the function button's LED will breathe RED. When the controller is fully charged, the LED will turn WHITE.

#### **Program Back Buttons**



While holding down the function button, press the back button you would like to assign a command to. The function button's LED will start flashing, indicating it's ready to map.

Press the button who's function you would like to assign to the back button. The function button's LED will flash 3 times, indicating a successfully mapped function.
