Operation

- 1. Install the fan on a dry, level and non-slippery surface.
- 2. Connect the fan to the mains.
- 3. Rotate the speed switch to the desired setting. (0 = off, 1 = low, 2 = medium, 3 = high)
- 4. Adjust the fan to the desired angle.
- 5. Switch off the fan and disconnect from the mains after use.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Before starting any cleaning activities:

- 1. Switch off the device.
- 2. Unplug the device's power cord from the outlet.

Cleaning

- 1. Switch off the appliance.
- 2. Unplug the appliance from the mains.
- 3. Clean the inlet and outlet ribs with a vacuum cleaner.

Do not disassemble the appliance.

Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid. Do not clean the appliance with water and never allow water to enter the motor and housing.

Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents or strong detergents.

Storing
