


#### **FAQs**

- Q: Can I use this GPU block on models other than ASUS ROG STRIX RTX 4090 and TUF GAMING RTX 4090?
  - A: The GPU block is specifically designed for ASUS ROG STRIX RTX 4090 and TUF GAMING RTX 4090 models. Using it on other models may not be compatible.
- Q: Do I need to remove the protective film on thermal pads?


- A: Yes, it is essential to remove the protective film on both sides of the thermal pads before installation.
- Q: How should I plan my water loop before installation?
  - A: Plan the inlet and outlet ports according to your water loop setup. The product provides multiple ports for flexibility, so plan accordingly before installing.


#### **SCOPE OF DELIVERY**





#### PLAN YOUR WATER LOOP AND ADJUST THE INLET AND OUTLET PORT ACCORDINGLY.







**PRO TIP** PH-GEF\_GPU4090AS is equipped with multiple ports to allow for more flexibility. Please plan your water loop before proceeding with installation.

## **REMOVING STOCK COOLER**

#### **ASUS ROG STRIX RTX 4090**



**APPLYING THERMAL PASTE & PADS** 




**PRO TIP** Clean off the thermal compound and use isopropanol. Place thermal pads correctly and apply thermal compound to the GPU center.

**WARNING** Make sure to remove the protective film on both sides of the thermal pads.


## **MOUNT THE WATER BLOCK**

## 1. SECURE THE SUPPORT BRACKET TO THE GPU BLOCK




• Carefully position the water block onto the graphics card. Align the mounting holes on the PCB with the holes on the water block.

## 2. SECURE THE WATER BLOCK



• Secure the Support Bracket with the original cooler screw.

## **APPLYING THERMAL PADS**




Remove the protective film on both sides and place the thermal pads in the correct position on the backplate.


## **INSTALLATION**

#### **INSTALL THE BACKPLATE**

1. SECURE THE 8X M2.5X8MM




## 2. SECURE THE 2X M2.5X6MM



• Carefully position the backplate onto the graphics card. Align the mounting holes on the PCB with the holes on the backplate.


## 1. CONNECT D-RGB CABLE






Connect to Phanteks Case



- **WARNING** Always perform a leak test before providing power to any system components.
- 2. INSTALL THE GPU INTO THE SYSTEM
- 3. INSTALL THE WATERLOOP
  - Hard Tube Installation




• Press down on the ring and install the soft tube.



Make sure to cut perpendicular to the tubing as shown.

#### • Soft Tube Installation


- 1. Install Insert
- 2. Press down on the ring and install the soft tube.



• **PRO TIP** Please put a drop of water into the fitting o-ring before installation.



#### 4. TUBE REMOVAL



• Press down on the ring and remove the tube.

WARNING: CHECK FOR LEAKS BEFORE TURNING ON THE SYSTEM

#### SAFETY INFORMATION

To achieve maximum safety, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:
