





Setting Up the Monitor


1. Place the monitor face down on a smooth surface to avoid scratching or damaging the screen.




2. Connect the power cable and any necessary cables (HDMI, USB) to the corresponding ports on the monitor.

3. If using a USB hub, connect it to the monitor following the provided instructions.

The monitor features input selection, SmartImage adjustments, volume control, and menu navigation controls. Follow these steps:

- 1. Use the input button to select the desired input source.
- 2. Adjust SmartImage settings for optimal display performance.
- 3. Control the volume using the dedicated volume buttons.
- 4. Navigate through the menu options using the menu buttons.
