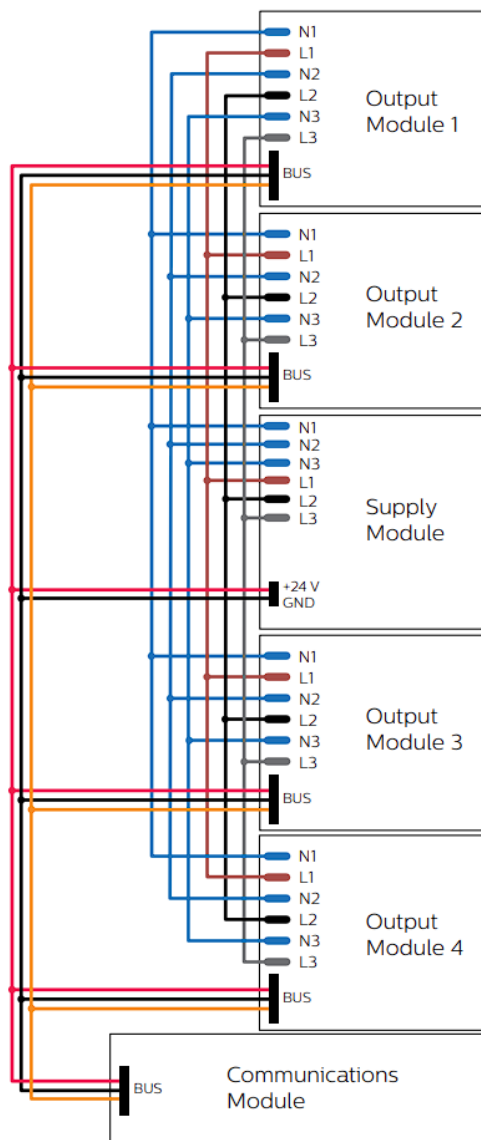


Devices must be installed by a qualified electrician in accordance with all national and local electrical and construction codes and regulations.

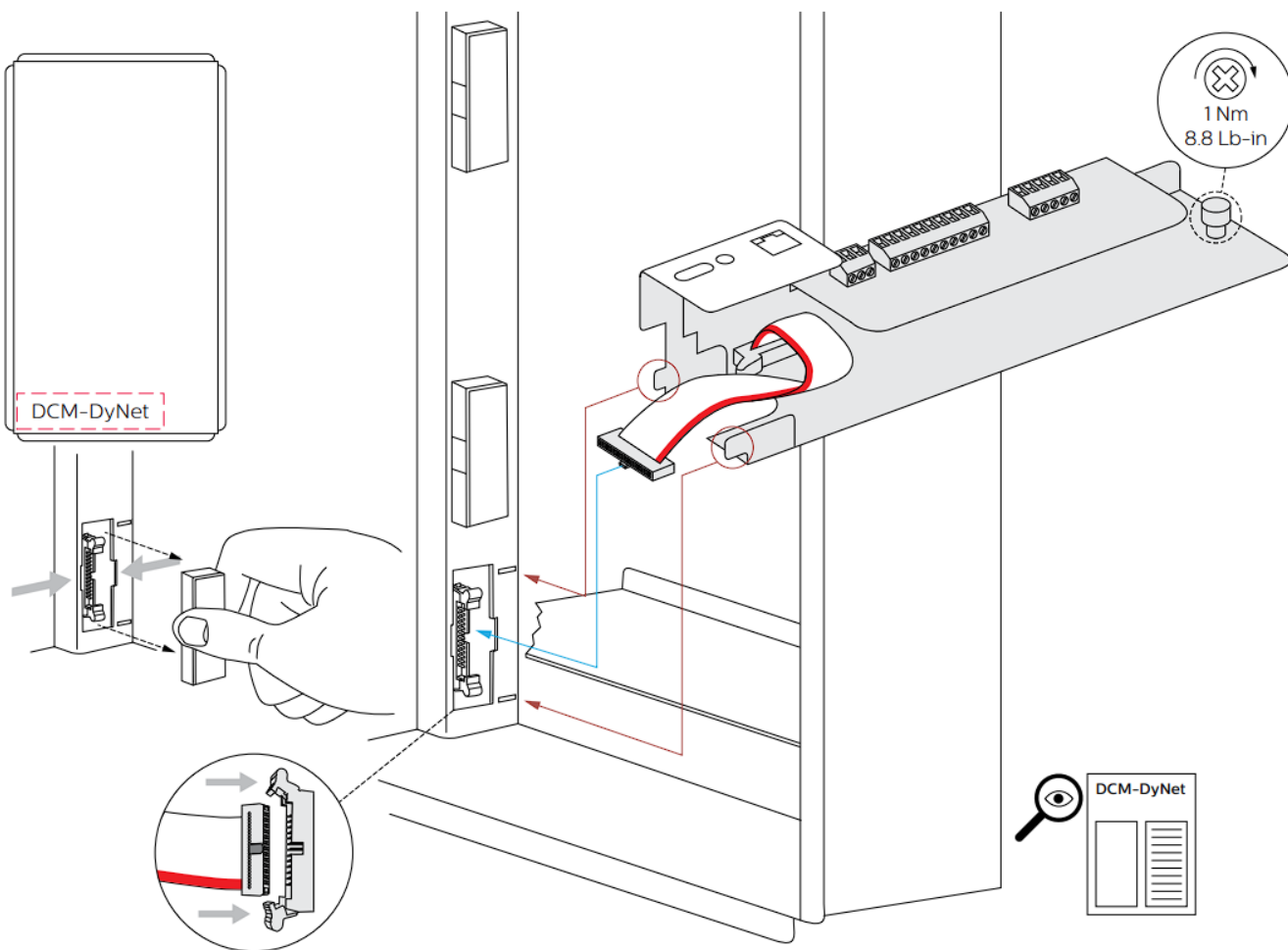
