- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions on the receiver to complete the firmware update process.

Can I install this firmware update on other Pioneer models?

No, this firmware update is only for the Pioneer In-Dash AV Receiver model DMH-ZF8550BT sold in Australia & New Zealand. Installing it on other models could cause damage.

How long does the firmware update process take?

This firmware update corrects the following matter.

• Corrects an issue with voice agent responses being cut off or not occurring.

To perform this update, the following items are needed:

- · Pioneer In-Dash AV Receiver
- Blank USB storage device (no files), 512 MB or larger in capacity, formatted to FAT32 or NTFS.
 Instructions on installing the firmware are provided on the same page as the firmware update. Installation of the update should take about fifteen minutes to complete.

How to Obtain the Free Firmware Update

- Download the firmware update files to a computer from the Pioneer website: https://www.pioneer.com.au/firmwaresoftware/
- 2. Transfer the files to the USB storage device for insertion into the Pioneer In-Dash AV Receiver.
