The AccessTM is a controller designed with safety in mind. It contains a lithium-ion battery and may emit radio waves. The product should not be disassembled or modified, and precautions should be taken when handling it to avoid injuries.

WARNING

RADIO WAVES

Precautions

Taking breaks

Light bar


Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use thinner, benzine, or alcohol. Avoid using wipes, chemical cloths, and other products that contain such substances.
