

General Guidelines

Before using the device, carefully read the user manual.

Installation

Place the device on a stable surface away from sources of interference.

Powering On

Connect the device to a power source following the instructions provided in the manual.

Operation

Follow the operational guidelines outlined in the user manual for optimal performance and compliance.

Maintenance

Regularly clean the device using a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or solvents.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What should I do if the device is causing interference?

A: If you experience interference issues, try relocating the device to a different position away from potential sources of interference.


Q: Can I modify the device for better performance?

A: No, any modifications not approved by the manufacturer may void your authority to operate the equipment.


Function Description

- 1. Vinyl Records
- 2. Moon lamp
- 3. Turn on/off and mode change button
 - 1. Long press: turn on/off turn on with bluetooth mode
 - 2. Short press: change the mode to AUX/TF card (Autoplay)/Bluetooth mode
- 4. Pause button

- 1. Short press: short press to play/pause music
- 5. Volume Button
 - 1. Short press: turn up/down the volume
 - 2. Long press: play to next music



- 6. Lamp change button
 - 1. Short press:white-blue-green-red-music-rhythm changing color-turn off
 - 2. Long press: Light brightness change
- 7. Speaker
- 8. TF card connection
- 9. Type connection
- 10. AUX connection



BT Connection

- After long pressing to turn on the Speaker, the mode starts with BT mode
- Search for the device named X7 in the BT interface, click Connect, and then manually switch to other modes. At the same time, the light has a power-on special effect and naturally transitions to the first colorful gradient.

Product Safety Guidelines & Precautions

- Maintain adequate space around the speaker for optimal sound performance.
- Do not stick any foreign matter into the mesh or charging port of the speaker. Do not hit the speaker hard or with other external force.
- Because the essential oil is corrosive, do not drop it in other places except the diffuser stone. After cleaning the stone, remember to dry it before putting it back into the product, otherwise it may damage the product.
- Keep away from heat sources, and do not go near open flames, microwave ovens, electric heaters, and other high-heat electrical appliances. To ensure safety, use the attached accessories only.
- If you have any problems, please contact the original factory or agents to consult professional maintenance personnel.
