

## **Battery Replacement**

- 1. Locate the push button near the battery tray at the rear.
- 2. Using a pin or similar object with a fine tip, press and hold down on the button while pulling on the battery tray to disconnect the tray from the remote controller.
- 3. Remove the pin and continue to pull the battery tray out completely.
- 4. Replace the old battery with a new one (Battery type: CR2032). Be sure the new battery is installed with the

correct polarity (+ and -).

5. Push the battery tray back into the remote controller.



#### **WARNING**

- 1. Dispose used battery properly. Observe local regulations regarding disposal of hazardous waste.
- 2. Ensure the batteries are installed correctly with regard to polarity (+ and -).
- 3. This product is powered by a lithium battery. Due to their small size, lithium batteries can easily be swallowed by children. Ingestion of such batteries has been known to cause death.
- 4. This product contains a lithium battery which if swallowed has been known to cause death.
- 5. Do not expose light set to moisture.
- 6. Remove batteries when not used for an extended period of time, or when depleted.
- 7. Clean the battery contacts prior to battery installation.
- 8. The external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire cannot be replaced; If the cord is damaged, the luminaire shall be destroyed.
- 9. Dispose of used batteries properly by following directions on batteries.
- 10. Use only CR2032 batteries for the remote controller.


