Product Usage Instructions

Setup:

- 1. Unbox the product and remove all packaging materials.
- 2. Place the floating speaker on a flat, stable surface.
- 3. Connect the necessary cables to power on the speaker.

Pairing:

- 1. Turn on the speaker and enable Bluetooth on your device.
- 2. Search for available Bluetooth devices and select the speaker to pair.
- 3. Once paired, you can start playing music through the speaker.


Charging

- 1. Use the provided charging cable to connect the speaker to a power source.
- 2. Allow the speaker to charge fully before first-time use.

Maintenance

- 1. Keep the speaker clean by wiping it with a soft, dry cloth.
- 2. Avoid exposing the speaker to water or extreme temperatures.

A: Yes, you can use the speaker while it is charging, but it may affect the charging time.

Q: How do I check the battery level of the speaker?

A: Some models have battery level indicators that show the remaining charge. Check the user manual for specific instructions for your model.
