Basic function



Indicator light



Mouse RF connection indicator

Working mode switching

Toggle switch,

1. wired mode when moved to the left "X";
2. RF mode when moved to the right "O";



DPI Setting

The level change of DPI is reflected on the RGB colors : 400(Light Blue)-800(Blue)-1600(Green)-3200(Yellow)-6400(Orange)-12800(Pink)



Press the “DPI” switch to change the DPI level;
DPI sets the step level [400-800-1600](#)-3200-6400-12800
