Control Panel Functions

The control panel of the speaker includes various buttons and ports. Here is a brief description of each

- DC 9V IN: Input port for DC power supply.
- 2. Control Panel Functions: Various buttons and controls for operating the speaker.
- 3. **REMOTE CONTROL FUNCTIONS:** Functions available on the remote control.
- 4. **MODE**: Button for selecting different modes of operation.
- 5. **LED ON/OFF:** Button to control the lighting feature.
- 6. **REPEAT:** Button to repeat a specific action or segment.
- 7. **REC:** Button to start recording.
- 8. **PLAY:** Button to start playing recorded content.
- 9. **ECHO-:** Button to decrease the echo volume.
- 10. **ECHO+:** Button to increase the echo volume.
- 11. BASS-: Button to decrease the bass volume.
- 12. BASS+: Button to increase the bass volume.
- 13. **MIC Volume-:** Button to decrease the microphone volume.
- 14. **MIC Volume+:** Button to increase the microphone volume.
- 15. **EQ:** Button to select different equalizer modes.
- 16. **TWS:** Button for TWS (True Wireless Stereo) functionality.
- 17. POWER ON/OFF: Button to turn the speaker on or off.
- 18. MP3/FM Buttons: Buttons for controlling MP3 playback and FM radio.
- 19. Replay: Button to replay a specific action or segment.
- 20. **Delete Record:** Button to delete recorded content.
- 21. MIC FRI Mode: Button to switch to microphone feedback reduction mode.
- 22. **Treble Volume-:** Button to decrease the treble volume.
- 23. Treble Volume+: Button to increase the treble volume.
- 24. Volume+/-: Buttons to increase or decrease the overall volume.

Wireless BT Connection

- 1. Set the On/Off Switch to the on position. If the speaker is in Standby mode, press the Power Button on the remote control to turn it on.
- 2. Press the MODE button on the unit or remote control repeatedly until 'BLUE' flashes on the display.
- 3. On your BT-enabled device, search for the speaker name 'PyleUSA' and choose it to connect.
- 4. When the device is connected, 'BLUE' will stop flashing and remain on the display. Your device will show as connected to 'PyleUSA'.

FM Radio Operation

- 1. Press MODE Button to switch to FM mode.
- 2. Press and release ` 'Button again to save a channel under auto scan.
- 3. Press and release ` ' or ` ' Button to select the previous or next channel.

USB/MicroSD Operation

- 1. Insert a USB or MicroSD card memory device into the corresponding slot to play mp3 files automatically.
- 2. Press and release ` 'Button to pause or play the music.
- 3. During music playing, press and release ` ' or ` ' Button to play the previous or next song.

FAQ

Q: How do I connect the speaker to a Bluetooth-enabled device?

A: To connect the speaker via Bluetooth, follow the "Wireless BT Connection" instructions provided in the user manual.

• Q: Can I use the speaker near water?

A: No, it is not recommended to use the speaker near water to avoid any damage or safety hazards.

Q: How do I adjust the volume of the microphone?

A: Use the "MIC Volume+" and "MIC Volume-" buttons on the control panel or remote control to adjust the microphone volume.

Q: Can I remove the cover on the speaker?

A: No, the cover should not be removed as there are no user-serviceable parts inside. Refer all servicing to a qualified technician.

Q: How do I delete recorded content?

A: Press the "Delete record" button on the control panel to delete recorded content.



 - · Do not install in an airtight location.


- 5. Keep the cord and plugs in good order.
- 6. The speaker may be wiped down with a damp cloth once the unit has been switched off and the plug removed
- 7. Unplug the speaker during lightning storms or when not in use for long periods of time.
- 8. Keep foreign objects and liquid from entering the unit to avoid a short circuit, fire and electrical accidents.
- 9. Keep the speaker in a dry location.

INSTRUCTIONS

Wireless BT Connection

- 1. Set the On/Off Switch to the on position. If the speaker is in Standby mode, press the Power Button on the remote control to turn it on.
- 2. Press the MODE button on the unit or remote control repeatedly until 'BLUE' flashes on the display.
- 3. On your BT-enabled device, search for the speaker name 'PyleUSA' and choose it to connect.
- 4. When the device is connected, 'BLUE' will stop flashing and remain on the display. Your device will show as connected to 'PyleUSA

FM Radio Operation

- 1. Press MODE Button to switch to FM mode.
- 2. Press and release " Button again to save a channel under auto scan.
- 3. Press and release '144 Button to select the previous or next channel.

USB/MicroSD Operation

- 1. Insert a USB or MicroSD card memory device into the corresponding slot to play mp3 files automatically.
- 2. Press and release ' Button to pause or play the music.
- 3. During music playing, press and release 'III' 'or' I'Button to play the previous or next song.

Important: To avoid damaging the USB/Micro SD device, do not take it out while music is being played from it.

Auxiliary AUX Operation

- 1. Use the provided audio cable to connect your external device's (e.g. mp3 player) audio out to the AUX input on the speaker
- 2. Press MODE Button to switch to AUX mode.
- 3. Turn on your external device and start playback.

TWS Function

This function allows you to connect two speakers wirelessly and to reproduce the music from the same source at the same time.

The process to connect two speakers is as below

- 1. Take 2 speakers and name them A and B, In advance, A unit switch to Wireless BT and start the scan function from your device and the phone will directly connect. Then also switch B unit to Wireless BT function and then press and hold button on A unit, it will change to TWS function and it will automatically connect to B unit. When the connection is successful, a "tick" tone will be heard on the B unit.
- 2. After connected successfully, on the B unit, the LED display will stop flashing, having static "Blue" word, then

you can hear the music from both the speaker, it becomes left and right channel, true stereo. Press the TWS button again to exit TWS.

SIMPLE TROUBLESHOOTING

Try the troubleshooting steps below if you are having problems while using your speaker. If problems still exist, please look for a qualified technician or contact our company. To prevent electric shock or expand the scope of the malfunction, do not repair by yourself.

Symptom	Possible problem	Solution
No function light & No sound	Low Battery	Insert the Adapter to charge the battery
	Speaker power button is not turned on	Turn on the button'
Function light on but no sound	Cable misconnected	Turn off the power, check the input jack to ensure p roper audio signal is connected to relevant input jack
	Speaker are not connected or miscon nected	Power off, then check and confirm the cable conne ction again
	Audio signal is not transmitted to spea ker	Check all the speaker if there is audio signal output

If the problem exists after checking related procedures above, please refer to the appointed service agent or professional technician to fix it. Do not attempt to open the cover, otherwise we assumes no responsibility.
